



 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## SIZE

One size to fit adult.

## GAUGE

24 sc and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Notes:** Hat is worked sideways.

Ch 2 at beg of rows **does not** count as hdc.

Ch 68.

**Foundation row:** 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to last 8 sts. 1 sc in each of next 8 ch. Turn.

**1st row:** Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of next 8 sts. 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS-see diagram) in each of next 58 hdc. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below st in previous row in each of next 58 hdc. 1 scbl in each of next 8 sts. Turn.

Rep these 2 rows until work from beg measures approx 20" [51 cm], when slightly stretched. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Weave end through last scbl of each row along top edge and gather tightly. Sew back seam.

## MATERIALS

Patons® Kroy Socks™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 166 yds/152 m)  
Flax (55011) **2 balls**

Size U.S. C/2 [2.75 mm] crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

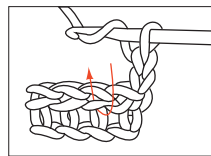
**Rep** = Repeat

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Scbl** = Single crochet in the back loop only

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side
