What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:

1 skein each 373 Petal Pink **A**, 311 White **B**, 512 Turqua **C**, and 312 Black **D**

Susan Bates® knitting needles:

5mm [US 8] (for slippers) and
5.5mm [US 9] (for robe)

Stitch markers, stitch holders,
yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" (10 cm); 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge given.

Doll Robe and Bunny Slippers

Get your doll ready for bed with the cutest knit bunny slippers and hooded robe. Young girls will love having these fashion items for a pajama party with their doll!

Fits 18" (45.5 cm) tall doll

Special Stitch

kfb (Knit into front and back) = Knit next st but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same st and remove from needle.

Notes

1. Robe is worked from the neck downwards. Piece is divided at underarms and body and sleeves worked separately down to lower edges.
2. Each slipper is worked from Garter stitch (knit every row) cuff down to sole. Ears are worked separately and sewn to slippers.

ROBE

Yoke

With larger needles and **A**, cast on 34 sts,

Row 1 (right side): [K1, place marker] twice, k7, place marker, k1, place marker, k14, place marker, k1, place marker, k7, place marker, k1, place marker, k1—34 sts.

Row 2: Purl across, slipping markers as you come to them.

Row 3: Kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, *kfb, knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker; repeat from * 2 more times, kfb—42 sts.

Row 4: Purl across, slipping markers as you come to them.

Row 5: [Kfb] twice, slip marker, k1, slip marker, *kfb, knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker; repeat from * 2 more times, [kfb] twice—52 sts.

Row 6: Purl across, slipping markers as you come to them.

Row 7: *Kfb, knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker; repeat from * 3 more times, kfb, knit to last st, kfb—62 sts.

Rows 8 and 9: Repeat Rows 6 and 7—72 sts.

Row 10: Purl across, slipping markers as you come to them.

Row 11: Cast on 3 sts, knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, *kfb, knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker; repeat from * 2 more times, kfb, knit to end of row—83 sts.

Row 12: Cast on 3 sts. purl across, slipping markers as you come to them—86 sts.

Row 13: Knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, *kfb, knit to 1 st before next marker, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker; repeat from * 2 more times, kfb, knit to end of row—94 sts.

Row 14: Purl across, slipping markers as you come to them.

Rows 15–18: Repeat Rows 13 and 14 twice—110 sts at the end of Row 17.

Do not bind off. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail to weave in later.

Divide for Body and Sleeves

Row 1 (right side): Remove markers as you work this row, k15 for left front, slip next 24 sts to a holder for left sleeve, k32 for back, slip next 24 sts to a holder for right sleeve, k15—62 sts remain on needle for body. Work in Stockinette st (knit on right, purl on wrong side) for 29 rows.

Eyelet Row (right side): *K1, yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Work in Stockinette st for 3 rows.

Bind off as if to knit, leaving a long tail to sew hem. Fold edge to wrong side at Eyelet Row and sew in place.

Left Sleeve

Return 24 left sleeve sts from holder to needle ready to work a wrong side row. Work even in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) for 9 rows.

SHOP KIT

Cuff Ribbing

Next 4 Rows: *K2, P2; repeat from * across. Bind off in rib pattern, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing sleeve seam. With yarn needle, sew sleeve seam.

Right Sleeve

Return 24 right sleeve sts from holder to needle ready to work a wrong side row. Complete same as Left Sleeve.

Left Front Band

Row 1 (right side): With right side facing and **A**, pick up and k32 sts evenly spaced across left front edge.

Row 2: Purl.

Eyelet Row (right side): *K1, yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Work in Stockinette st for 2 rows.

Bind off as if to purl, leaving a long tail to sew hem. Fold edge to wrong side at Eyelet Row and sew in place.

Right Front Band

Row 1 (right side): With right side facing and **A**, pick up and k32 sts evenly spaced across right front edge.

Complete same as Left Front Band.

Collar

Row 1 (right side): With right side facing and **A**, skipping edges of front bands, pick up and k50 sts evenly spaced around neck edge.

Row 2: *P2, k2; repeat from * across to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 3: *K2, p2; repeat from * across to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 4 and 5: Repeat Rows 2 and 3. Bind off in rib pattern.

Hood

With **A**, cast on 54 sts.

Beginning with a wrong side (purl) row, work even in Stockinette st for 29 rows.

Eyelet Row (right side): *K1, yo, k2tog; repeat from * across.

Work in Stockinette st for 3 rows.

Bind off as if to knit. Fold edge to wrong side at Eyelet Row and sew in place.

Belt

With **A**, cast on 6 sts.

Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from * across.

Repeat Row 1 until Belt measures 24" (61 cm).

Bind off.

FINISHING ROBE

Fold Hood in half at cast-on edge and with yarn needle, whip st edges together for back of Hood. Whip st Hood to inside of Row 1 of Collar.

With yarn needle and **A**, tack Belt to Robe at back and both sides of waist. Weave in ends.

SLIPPERS (make 2)

With smaller needles and **B**, cast on 16 sts.

Rows 1–4: Knit.

Row 5 (right side): K6, [kfb] 4 times, k6—20 sts.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: K8, [kfb] 4 times, k8—24 sts.

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: K10, [kfb] 4 times, k10—28 sts.

Row 10: Purl.

Row 11: Knit.

Change to **C**.

Row 12: With **C**, purl.

Row 13: [K2tog] twice, k6, [k2tog] 4 times, k6, [k2tog] twice—20 sts.

Row 14: Purl.

Row 15: [K2tog] twice, k2, [k2tog] 4 times, k2, [k2tog] twice—12 sts.
Bind off as if to purl.

Outer Ear (make 4 – 2 for each slipper)

With **B**, cast on 4 sts.

Rows 1–5: Beginning with a right side row, work in Stockinette st for 5 rows.

Row 6: [P2tog] twice—2 sts.

Row 7: K2tog.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. With yarn needle, thread long tail through remaining st and secure.

Inner Ear (make 4 – 2 for each slipper)

With **A**, cast on 3 sts.

Rows 1–5: Beginning with a right side row, work in Stockinette st for 5 rows

Row 6: P3tog.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. With yarn needle, thread long tail through remaining st and secure.

FINISHING SLIPPERS

Fold bind off edge of each slipper in half.

With yarn needle and **C**, whip stitch bind off edges together then whip stitch edges of Rows 12–15 together. With yarn needle and **B**, whip stitch edges of Rows 1–11 together.

Ears: With wrong sides together, yarn needle and **B**, whip stitch one Inner Ear to each Outer Ear. Using photo as a guide, with yarn needle and **B**, sew ears to slippers.

Facial Features: Use photo as a guide. With **D**, embroider 2 eyes on each slipper. With **A**, embroider a nose on each slipper. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, and **D** = Color A, Color B, Color C, and Color D; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit the next 2 stitches together; **p** = purl; **p2tog** = purl the next 2 sts together; **p3tog** = purl the next 3 stitches together; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
