



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =	Dc = Double crochet	Sp(s) = Space(s)
Approximately	Pat = Pattern	St(s) = Stitch(es)
Beg = Beginning	Rep = Repeat	
Ch = Chain(s)	Sc = Single crochet	

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9½" x 80" [24 x 203 cm].

GAUGE

13 sts and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start crocheting!
- Ch 3 at beg of rows counts as dc.

Ch 32 (multiple of 6 ch + 2). See diagram on page 2.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 31 sc.

2nd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in next sc. Skip next sc. *(1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) all in next sc. Skip next 2 sc. (2 dc. Ch 1. 2 dc) all in next sc. Skip next 2 sc. Rep from * to last 4 sts. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) all in next sc. Skip next sc. 1 dc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

MATERIALS

Caron® Big Donut™ O'Go™ (9.9 oz/280g; 502 yds/459 m)

Mint Julep (29008)

1 O'Go



Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

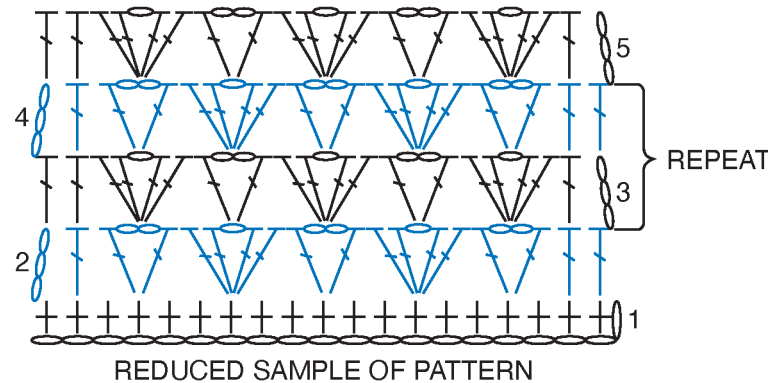
3rd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in next dc. *(2 dc. Ch 1. 2 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) all in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last ch-2 sp. (2 dc. Ch 1. 2 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Skip next dc. 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Turn.

4th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in next dc. *(1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) all in next ch-1 sp. (2 dc. Ch 1. 2 dc) all in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * to last ch-1 sp. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dc) all in next ch-1 sp. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Turn.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until work from beg measures 79¾" [202.5 cm].

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 dc. *Skip next 2 ch. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Skip next ch. Rep from * to last 4 sts.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 dc. *Skip next 2 ch. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Skip next ch. 1 sc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * to last 5 sts. Skip next 2 ch. 1 sc in each of last 3 dc. Fasten off. Skip next 2 ch. 1 sc in each of last 3 dc. Fasten off.
