Doll Witch Costume

Now dolls can go to the party in their own colorful witch costume. This crocheted ensemble coordinates with the Little Witch Hat & Shawl for girls, LW3821.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 356 Amethyst A, 722 Pretty 'n Pink B, 254 Pumpkin C and 312 Black D.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
4.25mm [US G-6]

Notions:

Yarn needle, Three ½" (12.7 mm) white buttons, Stitch markers, Sewing needle and white sewing thread

GAUGE: 12 sts dc = 4" (10 cm);
5 rows dc = 3" (7.5 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT

Dress fits: 18" (45.5 cm) doll

Special Abbreviations

Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog): [Insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw up a loop] twice, yarn over, draw through 3 loops on hook.

DRESS

Bodice

Starting at neck edge with **A**, ch 25.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn – 24 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in first sc, 2 dc in each sc across; turn – 48 dc.

Row 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, *dc in next st, 2 dc next st; repeat from * across; turn – 72 dc.

Rows 4–6: Ch 3, dc in each dc across; turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 9 dc, skip next 18 dc, sc in next 18 dc, skip next 18 dc, sc in last 9 dc; turn – 36 sc.

Rows 8–10: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

Peplum

Row 11: Ch 3, working in back loops of sts, dc in very first sc, 2 dc in each st across; turn – 72 dc.

Row 12: Ch 1, starting in first st, *sc in next 2 dc, 2 sc in next dc; repeat from * across; turn – 96 sc.

Row 13: Ch 3, dc in each sc across; turn.

Row 14: *Ch 4, slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, dc in next ch, skip next 2 dc in row 13, slip st in next dc; repeat from * across – 32 points. Fasten off.

Skirt

Row 15: With right side facing, working in remaining loops of sts in Row 10, join **A** with a slip st in front loop of first st, ch 3, dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each st across; turn – 7 2 dc.

Rows 16–26: Ch 3, dc in each dc across; turn.

Row 27: Ch 1, sc in each dc across; turn.

Points

Row 28: Ch 1, starting in first st, *sc in each of next 6 sc, ch 1, turn, sc2tog over first 2 sts, sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog over first 2 sts, ch 1, turn, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 1, turn, [sc2tog over first 2 sts] twice, ch 1, turn, sc2tog over first 2 sts, working in row-end sts, work 3 sc evenly spaced across side edge of point; repeat from * across – 9 points. Fasten off, leaving a long sewing length.

ASSEMBLY

Sew back seam to 1" (2.5 cm) below waist. Sew Peplum seam. Evenly space 3 buttons on top left side of Back and sew in place with sewing needle and thread. Use spaces between sts on right Back for button holes.

HAT

With **B**, ch 2.

Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join – 6 sc. Work in a spiral, marking beginning of each round and moving marker up as work progresses.

Round 2: *Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 9 sc.

Round 3: Sc in each sc around.

Round 4: *Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 12 sc.

Round 5: Sc in each sc around.

Round 6: *Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 18 sc.

Rounds 7–8: Sc in each sc around.

Round 9: *Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 24 sc.

Rounds 10–11: Sc in each sc around.

Round 12: *Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 30 sc.

Rounds 13–14: Sc in each sc around.

Continued...



Round 15: *Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 36 sc.

Rounds 16–18: Sc in each sc around.

Round 19: *Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 42 sc.

Rounds 20 & 21: Sc in each sc around.

Round 22: *Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 48 sc. Fasten off **B**, join **A**.

Rounds 23–25: With **A**, sc in each sc around. Fasten off **A**, join **B** with slip st in front loop of first sc.

Round 26: With **B**, ch 3, working in front loops of sts, dc in first st, 2 dc in each st around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3 – 96 dc.

Round 27: Ch 1, sc in each dc around; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

CAPE

Starting at neck edge with **C**, ch 78.

Row 1: Dc in 6th ch from hook, (beginning ch-5 counts as ch 1, dc, ch 1), *skip next 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch, skip next 2 ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, rep from * across; turn – 9 shells.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc, *skip next 2 dc, 5 dc in next dc, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc; repeat from * across, ending with last dc in top of turning ch; turn. Fasten off **C**, join **B**.

Rows 3–10: Repeat Row 2, working in the following color sequence: *2 rows **B**, 2 rows **C**; repeat from * once. Fasten off **C**, join **A**.

Row 11: With **A**, repeat Row 2, do not turn. Do not fasten off.

Edging

Round 1: Working in row-end sts on side edge of Cape, sc evenly across to next corner, working across opposite side of foundation ch of neck, sc in each ch across, ch 1, turn, *sc2tog over next 2 sc; repeat from * across neck edge to next corner, turn, ch 40 (for tie), slip st in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in each ch across, sc in each st across neck edge to next corner, ch 40 (for tie), slip st in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in each ch across, working in row-end sts on other side edge, sc evenly across to next corner; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3 of last row of cape. Fasten off.

PUMPKIN BAG

Starting at bottom edge with **C**, ch 12.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 9 ch, 3 sc in last ch, working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each of next 9 ch, 2 sc in last ch; do not join – 24 sc. Work in a spiral, marking beginning of each round, moving marker up as work progresses.

Round 2: 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 9 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 9 sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc – 30 sc.

Rounds 3–12: Sc in each sc around.

Round 13: *Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog over next 2 sts; repeat from * around – 24 sts.

Round 14: Sc in each of next 6 sc, ch 24 (for strap), skip next 6 sts, sc in each of next 6 sc, ch 24 (for strap), skip next 6 sts; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off **C**. With **D** and yarn needle, following photo, embroider 2 vertical satin st eyes, horizontal satin st nose and back st mouth.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, D = color A, B, C, D; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
