What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball 995 Ocean

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 2.25mm (US 1)

Fingertip Towel, Yarn Needle, Scissors and Tape Measure

GAUGE

Mitt: 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in pattern.

Towel Edging: 12 st repeat = 1½" (3.8 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

Use any size hook needed to obtain the gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls

SHOP KIT



Pampering Gift Set

Crochet a lovely gift set of a wash mitt and a hand towel enhanced with a feminine edging. Add a bar of soap and you have a gift with a made-just-for-you touch.

Finished size: Edging - 1½" (3.8 cm) wide.
Mitt – 6" X 12" (15 x 30.4 cm)

TOWEL EDGING

Ch multiple of 12 plus 8 for desired length.

Photographed towel is 128 ch for a 16" (40.6 cm) long edging.

Row 1: (Right Side): Dc in 8th ch from hook, * ch 2, skip next 2 ch, dc in next ch; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in same space, * ch 3, skip next space, 6 tr in next space, ch 3, skip next space, sc in next space, repeat from * across; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * ch 3, slip st in next tr, [ch 4, slip st in next tr] 5 times, ch 3, sc in next sc; repeat from * across; turn.

Row 4: Work 3 sc over row end, work across beginning ch, ch 1, *3 sc in next space; repeat from * across, 3 sc over row end; join. Fasten off.

WASHING MITT

Row 1: (Right side) Ch 47, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch from hook, *skip 2 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch; repeat from * across to last ch, dc in last ch; turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in ch-1 space; repeat from * across, dc in top of turning ch; turn.

Repeat Row 2 for 12" (30.4 cm) or to desired length. With right sides together, matching row ends, sew each side. Turn.

MITT EDGING

Attach thread in ch-1 space at seam, ch 5, dc in same space, * ch 2, dc in next space; repeat from * around, ch 2; join. Complete edging, beginning with Row 2. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = chain; **tr** = triple crochet; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **slip st(s)** = slip stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified. *** or **** = repeat whatever follows * or ** as indicated.
