



MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket Tiny™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 316 yds/288 m)
Main Color (MC) Polar Bear (14003) **6 balls**

Bernat® Softee® Baby Chunky™ (5 oz/140 g; 155 yds/142 m)
Contrast A Nighty Night (96017) **2 balls**

Bernat® Softee® Baby™ (5 oz/140 g; 362 yds/331 m)
Contrast B Mint (02004) **1 ball**

Sizes U.S. G/6 (4 mm) and U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hooks **or sizes needed to obtain gauges.** Tracing paper. Tapestry needle.

 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENT

Approx 50" [127 cm] square.

GAUGE

Bernat® Baby Blanket Tiny™:

15 sc and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook.

Bernat® Softee® Baby Chunky™:

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

BLANKET

With MC and smaller hook, ch 181.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. *1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from* to last ch. 1 dc in last ch. Turn. 180 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. *1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 50" [127 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

NUMBERS

Note: All Numbers are worked with larger hook and B.

Sts are worked into the single back ridge of foundation chain.

Number 1 (make 5)

Ch 22.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. *Draw up a loop in each of next 5 ch. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook - sc5tog made.* 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Fasten off.

Number 2 (make 2)

Ch 30.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. Sc5tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 5 times. 1 sc in next ch. Fasten off.

Number 3

Ch 34.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 5 times. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. Sc5tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 5 times. 1 sc in next ch. Fasten off.

Number 4

Ch 36.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 4 ch. Sc5tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 ch. Sc5tog. 1 sc in each of next 15 ch. Fasten off.

Number 5

Ch 33.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 6 times. 1 sc in next ch. *Draw up a loop in each of next 4 ch. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – sc4tog made.* 1 sc in each of next 4 ch. Sc4tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 ch. Fasten off.

Numbers 6 and 9 (make 2)

Ch 30.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. 2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in each of next 11 ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 7 times. Fasten off.

Number 7

Ch 23.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch. Sc4tog. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Fasten off.

Number 8

Ch 43.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 4 ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 5 times. 1 sc in each of next 8 ch. *(Draw up a loop in each of next 2 ch. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – sc2tog made.* 1 sc in next ch) 5 times. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Fasten off.

Number 0 (make 2)

Ch 35.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 9 ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 4 times. 1 sc in each of next 9 ch. (2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 3 times. 2 sc in next ch. Fasten off.

Blanket Finishing

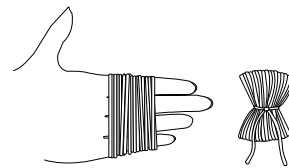
Following layout diagram on page 3, sew numbers to Blanket with A.

Using tracing paper, transfer 'months' to Blanket as indicated in layout diagram. With 2 strands of A held tog, embroider 'months' using chain st.

Pom-pom Ring

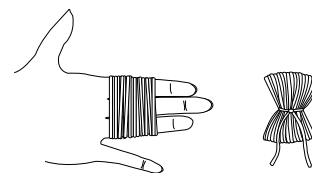
Large Pom-poms (make 8)

Wind B around 4 fingers approx 100 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to smooth round shape.



Small Pom-poms (make 8)

Wind B around 3 fingers approx 80 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to smooth round shape.



Attaching Pom-poms

Using a tapestry needle, thread a strand of B through all Pom-poms, alternating Large and Small Pom-poms. Tie ends of strand to form a circle.
