**Bernat® Bundle Up™** (4.9 oz/140 g; 267 yds/244 m)

Sizes	6	12	18	24	mos
<b>Main Color (MC)</b> Brook (74012)	2	2	3	3	<b>balls</b>
<b>Contrast A</b> Cloud White (74028)	1	1	1	1	<b>ball</b>
<b>Contrast B</b> Dove (74022)	1	1	1	1	<b>ball</b>
<b>Contrast C</b> Duckling (74019)	1	1	1	1	<b>ball</b>
<b>Contrast D</b> Posy (74023)	1	1	1	1	<b>ball</b>

Sizes U.S. H/8 (5 mm) and U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle. Stitch marker.

## SIZES

### To fit chest measurement

**6 mos** 17" [43 cm]

**12 mos** 18" [45.5 cm]

**18 mos** 19" [48 cm]

**24 mos** 20" [51 cm]

### Finished chest measurement

**6 mos** 19½" [49.5 cm]

**12 mos** 21½" [54.5 cm]

**18 mos** 23½" [59.5 cm]

**24 mos** 25½" [65 cm]

## GAUGE

16 sc and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the*

*instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.*

## Notes:

- Sweater is worked in one piece from neck edge down.
- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
- Ch 2 at beg of rnd **does not** count as hdc.
- To change colors, work to last loops on hook of stitch. Draw new color through last loops and proceed with new color.
- Larger hook used for foundation chain only to ensure neck opening is not tight.

With A and **larger** hook, beg at neck edge, ch **56 (60-64-68)** loosely (foundation ch needs to pull over baby's head). Join with sl st to first ch, taking care not to twist ch.

Change to smaller hook and proceed as follows:

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join B with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc around. Join C with sl st to first sc.

**3rd rnd:** With C, as 2nd rnd. Join D with sl st to first sc.

**4th rnd:** With D, as 2nd rnd. Join MC at end of rnd. Break A, B, C and D.

With MC only, proceed for Yoke as follows:

**1st rnd:** Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next **7 (8-9-10)** ch. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc – V-st made) in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 10 ch. V-st in next ch. 1 dc in each of next **16 (18-20-22)** ch. V-st in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 10 ch. V-st in next ch. 1 dc in each of last **8 (9-10-11)** ch. Join with sl st to top of ch-3.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 3. \*1 dc in each dc to ch-1 sp of next V-st. V-st in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Rep from \* 3 times more. 1 dc in each dc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to top of ch-3.

Rep last rnd **7 (8-9-10)** times more. **124 (136-148-160)** dc and 4 ch-1 sps at end of last rnd.

### Divide Sleeves and Body:

**1st rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **17 (19-21-23)** dc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Ch 3 for underarm. Skip next **28 (30-32-34)** dc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. 1 hdc in each of next **34 (38-42-46)** dc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Ch 3 for underarm. Skip next **28 (30-32-34)** dc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of next V-st. 1 hdc in each of last **17 (19-21-23)** hdc. Join with sl st to first hdc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc or ch around. Join with sl st to first hdc. **78 (86-94-102)** hdc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. Rep last rnd until work from underarm measures **6½ (7½-8-8½)" [16.5 (19-20.5-21.5) cm]**. Join A at end of last rnd. Break MC.

**Ribbing: 1st rnd:** With A, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each hdc around. Join B with sl st to first sc at end of 2nd rnd.

**2nd rnd:** With B, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc around. Join C with sl st to first sc.

**3rd rnd:** With C, as 2nd rnd.

**4th rnd:** With D, as 2nd rnd. Fasten off.

### SLEEVES

**1st rnd:** (RS). Join MC with sl st to center of underarm ch. Ch 2. 1 hdc in each ch or dc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. **31 (33-35-37)** hdc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. Rep last rnd until work from dividing rnd measures **2½ (3-3-4)" [6.5 (7.5-7.5-10) cm]**.

### Proceed in Stripe Pat:

**1st and 2nd rnds:** With A, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each st around. Join B with sl st to first sc at end of 2nd rnd.

**3rd and 4th rnds:** With B, as 1st and 2nd rnds.

**5th and 6th rnds:** With C, as 1st and 2nd rnds.

**7th and 8th rnds:** With D, as 1st and 2nd rnds. Join MC at end of last rnd.

**Next rnd:** With MC, ch 2. *Working in back loops only*, 1 hdc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first hdc.

**Next rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. Rep last rnd until work from underarm chain measures **6½ (7½-8-8½)" [16.5 (19-20.5-21.5) cm]**.

**Ribbing: 1st rnd:** With MC, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Rep last rnd once more. Fasten off.

### Saturn Applique:

**Note:** Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

**Circle:** With C and smaller hook, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 8 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.

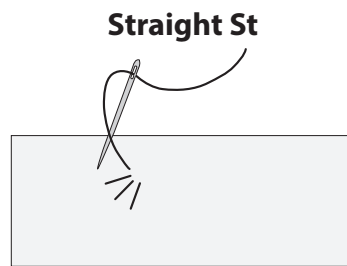
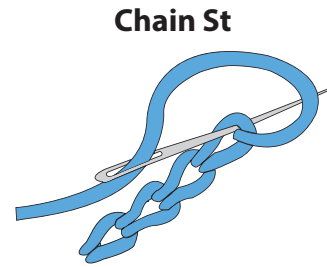
**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 8 times. Join. 24 sc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 8 times. Join. 32 sc.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 8 times. Join. 40 sc.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc) 8 times. Join. 48 sc.

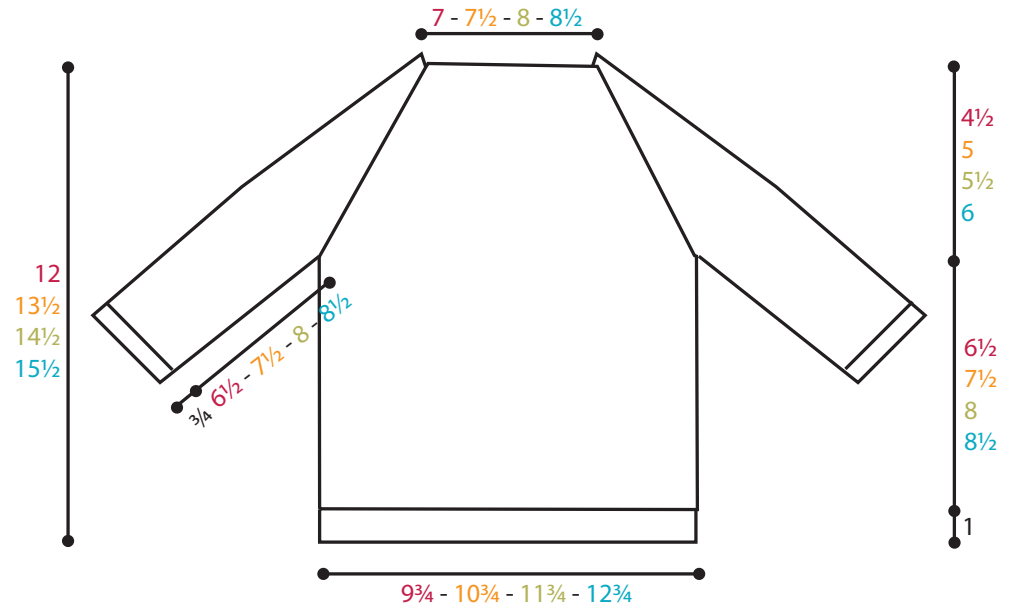
**7th rnd:** Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 8 times. Join. 56 sc. Fasten off.



Position Circle on center front as shown in picture and sew in position.

Using Chain St and 2 strands of yarn, embroider Saturn 'rings' as shown in picture in the following color sequence: A. B. MC. D.

With single strand of C, using straight st, embroider "Stars" randomly on front. Use picture as reference.
