



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Rep = Repeat

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 25" x 71" [63.5 x 180.5 cm],
excluding fringe.

GAUGE

13 stitches and 26 rows = 4"
[10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 84 stitches (sts).

Knit 13 rows (garter st), noting
1st row is Wrong Side (WS) and
ending on a WS row.

*(With B, knit 2 rows. With A, knit
2 rows) 4 times.

With B, knit 18 rows.

(With A, knit 4 rows. With B, knit
2 rows) 4 times.

With A, knit 18 rows.

(With B, knit 4 rows. With A, knit
2 rows) 4 times.**

With B, knit 18 rows.

(With A, knit 4 rows. With B, knit
4 rows) 4 times.

With A, knit 18 rows.

Repeat (Rep) from * once more,
then from * to ** once.

With B, knit 13 rows.

Cast off knitwise (WS).

Twisted fringe: Place markers
for each fringe spaced 1" [2.5 cm]
apart across both ends of Scarf,
noting 1 fringe will be in each
corner. Alternating A and B for
each twisted fringe, cut 4 lengths
of yarn 20" [51 cm] long. With
crochet hook, thread all 4 strands
at each marker of Scarf and have
someone hold opposite end. Twist
strands to right until they begin
to curl. Fold 2 ends together (tog)
Wrap yarn 6 times around fringe
½" [1.5 cm] from end and fasten
securely. The strands will now
twist themselves tog.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Wavelength™ (5 oz/140 g; 223 yds/204 m)

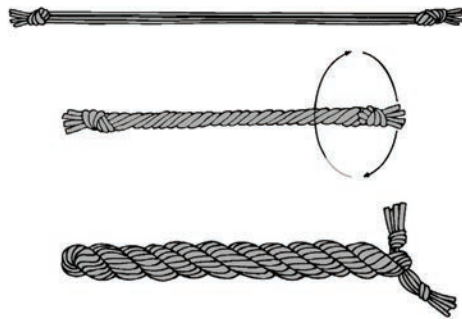
Contrast A Pearl (07001) **3 balls**

Contrast B Snowflake Obsidian (07002) **3 balls**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook for fringe. Stitch markers.
