## What you will need:

RED HEART® Shimmer®: 2 balls  
00010 Royal

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

TENSION/GAUGE: 12 tr = 10cm  
[4"]; 6 rows = 10cm [4"]. CHECK  
YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any  
size hook to obtain the tension/  
gauge.

# Heavenly Wrap

*This lightweight wrap can be quickly  
crocheted with soft yarn that has a bit of  
sparkle. It is wonderful to take along to warm  
you in feminine style.*

**Finished size, lightly blocked**  
35.5cm [14"] x 140cm [55"]

## WRAP

Ch 164.

**Row 1:** Tr in 4th ch from hook and in each ch  
across; turn — 161 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first tr), tr in each st  
across; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 7 (counts as tr and ch 4), skip first  
4 sts, \*dc in next st, ch 3, (dc, ch 5, dc) all in  
next st, ch 3, dc in next st, ch 4, skip next 3  
sts, tr in next st, \*\*ch 4, skip next 3 sts; repeat  
from \* across, end at \*\*; turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 7 (counts as dc and ch 4), dc in  
next ch-5 space, \*ch 4, skip next ch-3 space,  
dc in 4th ch of ch-4, ch 3, (dc, ch 5, dc) all in  
next tr, ch 3, dc in first ch of ch-4, ch 4, skip  
next ch-3 space, dc in next ch-5 space; repeat  
from \* across to last ch-3 space, ch 4, tr in  
3rd ch of ch-7; turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, dc in first tr, ch 4, dc in next  
dc, \*ch 4, skip next ch-4 and ch-3 spaces,  
dc in next ch-5 space, ch 4, skip next ch-3  
and ch-4 spaces, dc in next dc; repeat from  
\* across to ch-7 space, ch 4, dc in 3rd ch of  
ch-7; turn.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, \*4 tr in next ch-4 space, tr in  
next dc; repeat from \* across; turn — 161 tr.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 2.

**Row 8:** Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 2), skip first 3  
sts, 3 tr in next st, ch 2, skip next 3 sts, \*dc  
in next 3 sts, ch 2, skip next 3 sts, 5 tr in next  
tr – fan made, ch 2, skip 3 tr; repeat from \* to  
last 4 sts, dc in last 4 sts; turn.

**Row 9:** Ch 3, skip first 2 dc, 3 tr in next dc,  
\*skip next dc, ch 2, skip next tr, dc in next 3  
tr, skip next tr, ch 2, skip next dc, fan in next  
dc; repeat from \* across to last 3 tr, ch 2, dc in  
next 3 tr, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of ch-5; turn.

**Row 10:** Ch 3, tr in each ch-2 space, dc, and tr  
across to beginning ch-3 space, tr in space, tr  
in top of ch-3 space; turn — 161 tr.

**Row 11:** Repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 3-11 one time then repeat Rows  
3-7 one more time.

**Row 26:** Ch 1, dc in first st, ch 3, slip st in  
first ch – picot made, \*dc in next 3 sts, picot;  
repeat from \* to last st, dc in last st.

Fasten off.

Repeat Row 26 in unused loops of beginning  
ch on other long side, turn piece 90 degrees to  
work along short side.

## Side Edging

**Row 1:** Ch 3, work 50 tr spaced evenly along  
short edge; turn—51 tr.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, 2 tr in first st, \*skip 4 tr, 5 tr in  
next tr; repeat from \* to last 5 sts, skip 4 tr, 3  
tr last tr; turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, 2 tr in same st, \*skip 4 tr, (3 tr,  
picot, 2 tr) all in next tr; repeat from \* across  
to last 5 sts, skip 4 tr, 3 tr in top of beginning  
ch-3.

Fasten off.

With Right Side facing, turn work and repeat  
Side Edging Rows 1-3 on other short side.

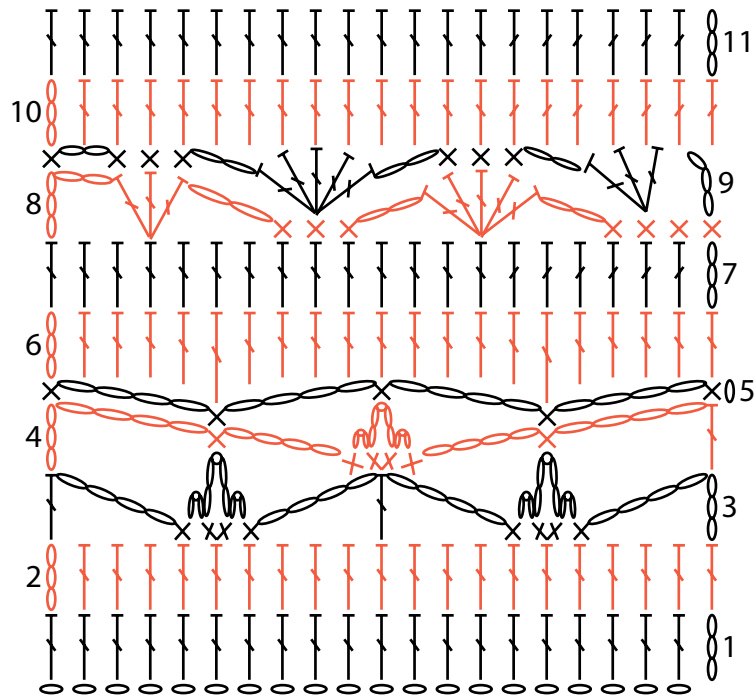

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
