Patons ${ }^{\oplus}$ Lincoln Fog ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g} ; 190 \mathrm{yds} / 174 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Wisteria (12017)
4 balls
Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
(c50) BULKY CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
$\mathrm{Ch}=$ Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Dc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a
loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.
Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.
Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 60" [152.5 cm] wide x 30" [76 cm] deep

## GAUGE

11 sc and 13 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc. Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc. Move marker to each center ch-3 sp.
See diagram on page 2.

Hdc = Half double crochet
Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker
Rep $=$ Repeat
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## Ch 4.

1st row: (WS). (3 dc. Ch 3.4 dc ) in 4th ch from hook. Turn. 8 dc and ch-3 sp.
2nd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. Ch 2. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next dc. ( 1 dc . Ch 3.1 dc in next ch-3 sp). PM on ch-3 sp for center. Ch 2. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2 . Skip next dc. 2 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.

## 三- Patons pratr fucre choches shawl crochiel

3rd row: Ch 2. 2 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in next dc. *3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Skip next dc. Rep from * to center ch-3 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 3. 2 hdc) in center ch-3 sp. **Skip next dc. 3 hdc in next ch- 2 sp . Rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 2 dc .1 hdc in next dc. 2 hdc in top of ch 3. Turn.

4th row: Ch 2.2 dcbp around first hdc. 1 dcbp around each hdc to center ch-3 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 3.2 hdc) in center ch-3 sp. 1 dcbp around each hdc to last hdc. 2 dcbp around last hdc. Turn.
5th row: Ch 3.1 dc in first dc. *(1 dc. Ch 2.1 dc) in next st - V-st made. Skip next 2 sts.* Rep from * to * to last dc before center ch-3 sp. V-st in last dc before center ch-3 sp. (1 dc. Ch 3.1 dc ) in center ch-3 sp. Rep from * to * to last 2 dc . V-st in next dc. 2 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.
6th row: Ch 2.2 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in next dc. *3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Skip next 2 dc . Rep from * to center ch-3 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 3. 2 hdc) in center ch-3 sp. **Skip next 2 dc .3 hdc in next ch-2 sp. Rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 3 dc . Skip next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 2 hdc in top of ch 3. Turn.

Rep 4th to 6th rows, noting reps between * to * will be increased until Shawl from beg along center measures approx 30 " $[76 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on 5th row.

## DIAGRAM

Border row: Ch 3. Dc2tog in $s p$ between first 2 dc . Ch 6. Sl st in 4th ch from hook. Ch 2. Dc2tog in same sp as last dc2tog - Cluster made. Skip next 2 dc. *Cluster in next ch-2 sp. Skip next 2 dc.* Rep from * to * to center ch-3 sp. (Cluster. Ch 6. Sl st in 4th ch from hook. Ch 2. Cluster) all in center ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Rep from * to * to last 3 dc. Cluster in sp between last 2 dc . Fasten off.

STITCH KEY
$\sigma=$ chain (ch)

- = slip stitch (sl st)

T = half double crochet (hdc)
$F=$ double crochet (dc)
$f=$ back post dc (dcbp)
$\bar{A}=$ double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)
