**Finished bust measurement**  
**XS/S** 42" [106.5 cm]

## GAUGE

17 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes

Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as hdc.

When joining new color, work to last loops on hook of last st. Draw new color through loops, then proceed in new color.

### POCKET LINING (make 1)

**With C, ch 18 (18-18-22-22-24).**

**1st row:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. **17 (17-17-21-21-23)** sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until piece measures 5" [12.5 cm]. Fasten off.

### FRONT

**\*\*Ribbing:** With A, ch 18.

**1st row:** 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 16 hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Work 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram on page 4) in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Ribbing measures **21 (22-24-25-29-33)" [53.5 (56-61-63.5-73.5-84)** cm] long (when slightly stretched), ending on a WS row.

**Do not** fasten off.

Turn Ribbing to work across long straight edge.

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. Work 90 (**94-102-106-124-140**) sc evenly across long straight edge. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch **3** (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**4th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

**5th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows to form pat. Cont in pat until piece from lower edge measures approx 7" [18 cm], ending on a 4th row. Break A, join B.\*\*

**Place Pocket Lining:** **1st row:** (RS). With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first **16 (18-18-20-22-22)** sc. Skip next **17 (17-17-21-21-23)** sc. 1 sc in each of next **17 (17-17-21-21-23)** sc from Pocket Lining. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. With B, cont in pat until Front measures approx 20" [51 cm], ending on a 4th row. Break B, join A.

**Shape armholes: 1st row:** (RS). With A, sl st in each of first **4 (6-6-5-5-6)** sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next **82 (82-90-96-114-128)** sc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – beg dc2tog made. 1 dc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dc2tog over last 2 sc. Turn. **80 (80-88-94-112-126)** sts.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each st to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. **78 (78-86-92-110-124)** sts. Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at each end of every row to **74 (74-80-88-106-110)** sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures approx **7 (7-8-8-8½-8½)" [18 (18-20.5-20.5-21.5-21.5)** cm], ending on a 4th row.

**Shape neck: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first **26 (26-28-32-40-42)** sts (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch **3** (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc to last 2 sts. Dc2tog. Turn. Cont in pat, dec 1 st at neck edge only to **20 (20-22-26-34-36)** sts. Work **2 (2-1-2-2-2)** row(s) even. Fasten off.

With RS facing, skip next **22 (22-24-24-26-26)** sc. Join A with sl st to next sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn.

**Next row:** Beg dc2tog. 1 dc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Cont in pat, dec 1 st at neck edge only to **20 (20-22-26-34-36)** sts. Work **2 (2-1-2-2-2)** row(s) even. Fasten off.

### BACK

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Front.

With B, cont in pat until Back measures same length as Front to armholes, ending on a 4th row. Break B, join A.

**Shape armholes: 1st row:** (RS). With A, sl st in each of first **4 (6-6-5-5-6)** sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next **82 (82-90-96-114-128)** sc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

**2nd row:** Beg dc2tog. 1 dc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dc2tog over last 2 sc. Turn. **80 (80-88-94-112-126)** sts.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each st to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. **78 (78-86-92-110-124)** sts. Keeping cont

of pat, dec 1 st at each end of every row to **74** (**74-80-88-106-110**) sts. Cont even in pat until armhole measures approx **8** (**8-9-9-9½-9½**)" [**20.5** (**20.5-23-23-24-24**) cm], ending on a 4th row.

**Shape neck: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. Pat across each of first **26** (**26-28-32-40-42**) sts (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch **3** (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dc2tog. Turn. Cont as established, dec 1 st at neck edge only to **20** (**20-22-26-34-36**) sts.

Work **2** (**2-1-2-2-2**) row(s) even. Fasten off.

With RS facing, skip next **22** (**22-24-24-26-26**) sc. Join A with sl st to next sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn.

**Next row:** Beg dc2tog. 1 dc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Cont as established, dec 1 st at neck edge only to **20** (**20-22-26-34-36**) sts. Work **2** (**2-1-2-2-2**) row(s) even. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

**Ribbing:** With A, ch 18.

**1st row:** 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 16 hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Work 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram) in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Ribbing measures approx **8½** (**8½-9-9-10-10**)" [**21.5** (**21.5-23-23-25.5-25.5**) cm] long when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. **Do not** fasten off.

Turn Ribbing to work across long straight edge.

**1st row:**(RS). Ch 1. Work **38** (**38-40-40-44-46**) sc evenly across long straight edge. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch **3** (counts as dc). 1 dc in first sc (inc made). 1 dc in each sc to last sc. 2 dc in last sc. Turn. **40** (**40-42-42-46-48**) dc.

**4th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

**5th row:** Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. **42** (**42-44-44-48-50**) sc.

Cont in pat as established, inc 1 st at each end of row on every 4th row to **68** (**72-76-76-80-84**) sts.

Cont even in pat until Sleeve from beg measures **20** (**20-20-21-21-21**)" [**51** (**51-51-53.5-53.5-53.5**) cm]. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves, centering sleeve at shoulder and easing sleeve into armholes. Sew Pocket Lining in position on WS.

**Neckband:** With A, ch 8.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sctbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Neckband measures length to fit around neck edge, when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. Fasten off. Sew neckband seam. Place neckband seam at left shoulder seam and sew long edge of neckband to neck edge, stretching neckband slightly to fit.
