Bernat® Maker Fashion™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 126 yds/115 m)

Sizes	XS/S	M	L	XL	2/3XL	4/5XL	balls
Blue (06007)	6	6	7	8	10	12	
640 yds/585 m / 750 yds/685 m / 870 m/795 m / 1000 m/910 yds / 1250 yds/1140 m / 1500 m/1365 yds							

Size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) knitting needles. Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Stitch marker. 2 stitch holders.

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

Extra-Small/Small	28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

GAUGE

13 sts and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on **57 (**63-67-75-83-93**) sts.

Knit 7 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS and inc **4** (**4-6-6-8-8**) sts evenly across last row. **61** (**67-73-81-91-101**) sts.

Change to larger circular needle. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd and 4th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows.

5th row: Knit.

6th row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

7th and 8th rows: As 5th and 6th rows.

These 8 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 11" [28 cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape sides: Inc 1 st each end next and following alt rows 3 times more. **69** (**75-81-89-99-109**) sts, taking inc sts into pat. Work 1 row even in pat.

Shape sleeves: Keeping cont of pat, cast on **12** (**12-12-10-8-8**) sts at beg of next 2 rows. **93** (**99-105-109-115-125**) sts. Place marker at end of last row.**

Cont even in pat until work from marker measures **7** (**7-8-8-9-9**)" [**18** (**18-20.5-20.5-23-23**) cm], ending on a WS row.

BERNAT® TEXTURED TEE KNIT PULLOVER | KNIT

Shape neck: Next row: (RS). K34 (37-39-41-43-48) (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows. 32 (35-37-39-41-46) sts.

Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off.

With RS facing, slip center 25 (25-27-27-29-29) sts onto a st holder. Rejoin yarn to rem sts and knit to end of row.

Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows. 32 (35-37-39-41-46) sts.

Work 1 row even in pat. Cast off.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont even in pat until work from marker measures 5½ (5½-6½-6½-7½-7½)" [14 (14-16.5-16.5-19-19) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: Next row: (RS). K37 (40-42-44-46-51) (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

***Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows, then on following alt rows 3 times more. 32 (35-37-39-41-46) sts.

Cont even in pat until Front measures same length as Back to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.***

With RS facing, slip center 19 (19-21-21-23-23) sts onto a st holder. Rejoin yarn to rem sts and knit to end of row.

Work from *** to *** as given above.

FINISHING

Block all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Sew right shoulder seam.

Neckband: With RS facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 9 sts down left front neck edge. K19 (19-21-21-23-23) from front st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 9 sts up right front neck edge and 4 sts down right back neck edge. K25 (25-27-27-29-29) from Back st holder, dec 2 sts evenly across. Pick up and knit 4 sts up left back neck edge. 67 (67-71-71-75-75) sts.

Knit 2 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).

Sew left shoulder and neckband seam.

Sleeve edging: With RS facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 51 (51-57-57-61-61) sts along sleeve edge.

Knit 2 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).

Sew side and sleeve seams.
