## What you will need:

**Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10:** 1 ball each 422 Golden Yellow **A**, 12 Black **B**, and 494 Victory Red **C**

**Note:** Only small quantities of each color are needed for this project.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 2.75 mm [US C-2]

**Susan Bates® Steelite Crochet Hook:** 2.35 mm [1]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

**GAUGE:** Approximately 7 sc = 1" [2.5 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Cool Sun Appliqué

Put a little sunshine into your life with this bright crochet appliqué! It's an easy crochet thread pattern that can be sewn to any fabric or attached with fabric glue. Or you can glue on a felt backing and hang from your backpack or bag!

**Sun measures 3" [7.5 cm] across widest point.**

**Note:** Use double strand of Thread and larger hook throughout, except for Sunglasses as directed.

## Special Stitches

**sc2tog** = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**sc3tog** = [draw up a loop in next st] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## SUN

Beginning at center, with **A**, ch 2.

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook (do not join)—6 sc. Place marker for beginning of Round and move marker up as each Round is completed.

**Round 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

**Round 3:** \*Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around—18 sc.

**Round 4:** \*Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around—24 sc.

**Round 5:** \*Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around—30 sc.

**Round 6:** \*Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around—36 sc.

**Round 7:** \*Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around—42 sc.

## Ray (make 7)

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in next 6 sc; turn—6 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, sc2tog, sc in last 2 sc; turn—5 sts.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc3tog, sc in last sc; turn—3 sts.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc3tog; turn—1 st.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in top of st, do not turn but work 3 slip sts down side of Ray, sc in same sc on Sun as last sc of Row 1 was worked—Ray completed.

At end of 7th Ray, join with slip st in next sc of Round 7 of Sun. Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Sunglasses (make 2)

Using smaller steel hook and single strand of **B**, ch 4; work 11 dc in 3rd ch from hook (ch-3 counts as first dc); join with slip st in top of ch-3—12 dc. Fasten off, leaving end for sewing.


## Assembly

Referring to photo for placement, sew Sunglasses in place. Using double strand of **C**, embroider with couched stitches to create smile.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
