STRIPES & CHECKS

SIZES

Bust/chest measurement

Small	30-32 ins	[76-81 cm]
Medium	34-36 ins	[86-91 cm]
Large	38-40 ins	[97-102 cm]
X-Large	42-44 ins	[107-112cm]

Finished bust/chest

Small	42 ins	[107 cm]
Medium	45 ins	[114.5 cm]
Large	48½ ins	[123 cm]
X-Large	52 ins	[132 cm]

TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

MATERIALS

Patons Decor (100 g/3.5 oz) or
Patons Classic Wool (100 g/3.5 oz)

Size	S	M	L	XL	
Main Color (MC) (Dk Blue)	2	2	2	3	balls
Contrast A (Red)	2	2	2	2	balls
Contrast B (Med Brown)	2	2	2	2	balls
Contrast C (Dk Green)	2	2	2	2	balls
Contrast D (Med Blue)	2	2	2	2	balls
Contrast E (Med Grey)	2	2	2	2	balls

Sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** 2 st holders.

ABBREVIATIONS

yf = take yarn to front of work.
yb = take yarn to back of work.
Sl1P = slip next st purlwise.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

Note: When working with 2 colors in 1 row, carry yarn not in use loosely across WS of work. The colors are never twisted around one another.

BACK

With A and smaller needles cast on 102 (110-118-126**) sts.

*****1st row:** (WS). Knit.

2nd and 3rd rows: With B, knit.

4th and 5th rows: With MC, knit.

6th and 7th rows: With E, knit.

8th and 9th rows: With D, knit.

10th row: With C, knit.***

11th row: With C, knit inc 4 sts evenly across. 106 (**114-122-130**) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). With A, knit.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: Knit.

4th row: K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

5th row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

6th row: Purl.

7th row: Knit.

8th row: Purl.

9th row: With B, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

10th row: *With B, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

11th row: With MC, knit.

12th row: Purl.

13th and 14th rows: As 11th and 12th rows.

15th row: With E, K2. *With MC, K2. With E, K2. Rep from * to end of row.

16th row: With E, K2. *With MC, P2. With E, K2. Rep from * to end of row.

17th row: With MC, knit.

18th row: With MC, purl.

19th and 20th rows: As 17th and 18th rows.

21st row: With D, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

22nd row: *With D, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

23rd to 30th rows: With C, as 1st to 8th rows.

31st and 32nd rows: With A, knit.

33rd row: With B, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

34th row: *With B, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

35th and 36th rows: With MC, knit.

37th row: With E, K4. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

38th row: With E, K5. *yf. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to last st. K1.

39th and 40th rows: With D, knit.

41st row: With C, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

42nd row: *With C, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

43rd and 44th rows: With A, knit.

45th to 52nd rows: With B, as 1st to 8th rows.

53rd row: With MC, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

54th row: *With MC, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

55th row: With E, knit.

56th row: With E, purl.

57th and 58th rows: As 55th and 56th rows.

59th row: With D, K2. *With E, K2. With D, K2. Rep from * to end of row.

60th row: With D, K2. *With E, P2. With D, K2. Rep from * to end of row.

61st row: With E, knit.

62nd row: With E, purl.

63rd and 64th rows: As 61st and 62nd rows.

65th row: With C, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

66th row: *With C, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

67th to 74th rows: With D, as 1st to 8th rows.

75th and 76th rows: With E, knit.

77th row: With D, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

78th row: *With D, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

79th and 80th rows: With C, knit.

81st row: With A, K4. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

82nd row: With A, K5. *yf. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to last st. K1.

83rd and 84th rows: With B, knit.

85th row: With MC, K2. *yb. Sl1P. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

86th row: *With MC, K3. yf. Sl1P. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

87th and 88th rows: With E, knit.

These 88 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 16 (**16½-17-17½**) ins [40.5 (**42-43-44.5**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Armhole shaping: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 10 (**12-14-17**) sts beg next 2 rows. 86 (**90-94-96**) sts.**

Cont in pat until armhole measures 9½ (**10-10½-10½**) ins [24 (**25.5-26.5-26.5**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 12 (**13-13-14**) sts beg next 2 rows, then 13 (**13-14-14**) sts beg following 2 rows. Leave rem 36 (**38-40-40**) sts on a st holder.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont in pat until armhole measures 6½ (**6¾-7¼-7¼**) ins [16.5 (**17-18.5-18.5**) cm] ending with a WS row.

Neck shaping: Next row: Pat across 34 (**36-37-38**) sts (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows, then on following alt rows until there are 25 (**26-27-28**) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 12 (**13-13-14**) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 13 (**13-14-14**) sts.

With RS of work facing slip next 18 (**18-20-20**) sts from spare needle onto a st holder. Join yarn to rem sts and pat to end of row.

Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows, then on following alt rows until there are 25 (**26-27-28**) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shoulder shaping: Cast off 12 (**13-13-14**) sts beg next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 13 (**13-14-14**) sts.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles cast on 44 (44-46-46) sts.

Work from *** to *** as given for Back.

11th row: With C, knit inc 6 (10-8-12) sts evenly across. 50 (54-54-58) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as given for Back for 4 rows.

Keeping cont of pat, as placed in last 4 rows, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and following 4th rows until there are 78 (86-90-90) sts, then every following 6th row until there are 94 (100-104-104) sts, taking inc sts into pat.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 18 (18½-19-19) ins [45.5 (47-48-49.5) cm], ending with RS facing for next row. Place a marker at each end of last row.

Cont even in pat for 14 (16-18-20) rows. Cast off.

Pick up and knit 19 (21-21-23) sts up right front neck edge. Knit across 36 (38-40-40) sts from back st holder. 92 (98-102-106) sts.

Work from *** to *** as given for Back.

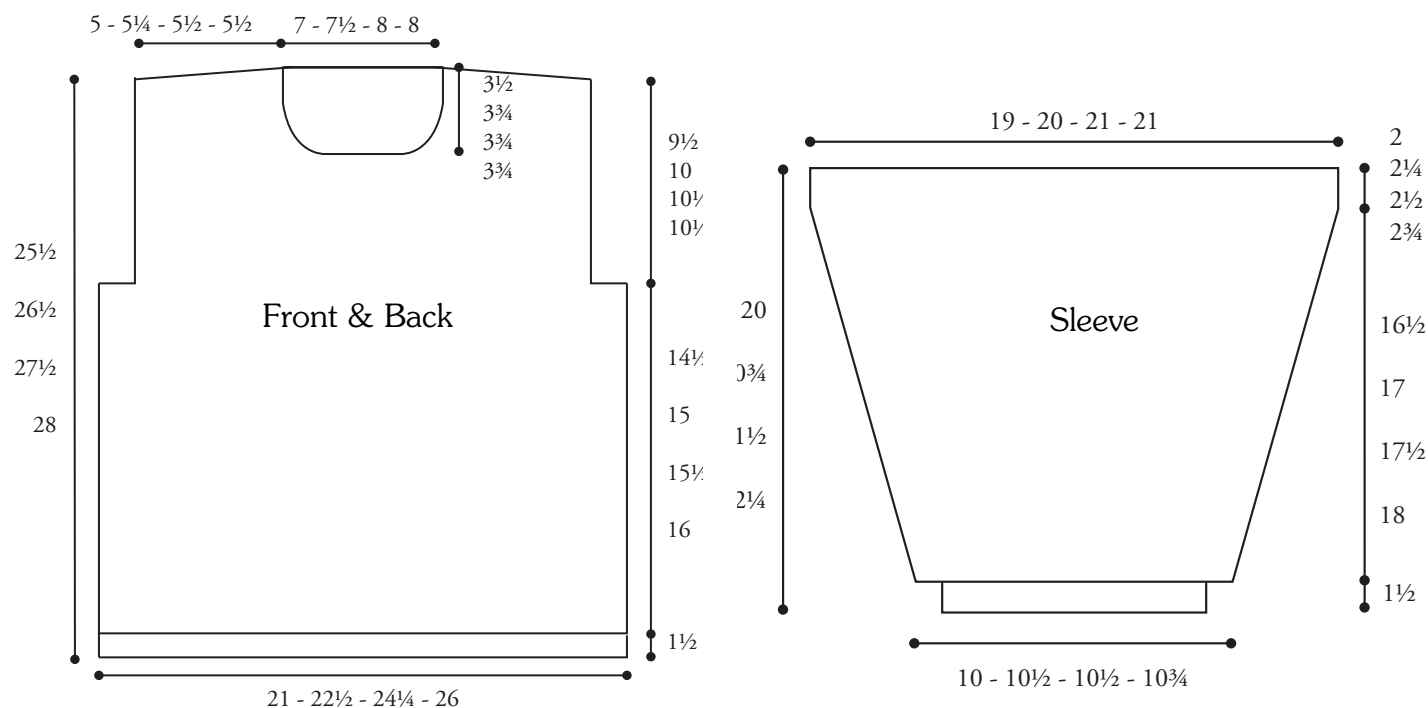
With C, cast off knitways (WS).

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

Sew in sleeves placing rows above markers along cast off sts at armholes to form square armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing, A and smaller needles, pick up and knit 19 (21-21-23) sts down left front neck edge. Knit across 18 (18-20-20) sts from front st holder.



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
