



LILY® SUGAR'N CREAM®

RED WHITE AND BLUE DISH CLOTH (TO KNIT)

MEASUREMENT

Approx 10" [25.5 cm] square, excluding hanging loop.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (70.9 g/2.5 oz; 109 m/120 yds)

White (00001)

or Bright Navy (00009)

or Red (00095)

1 ball or 50 m/55 yds

Note: 1 ball makes 2 Dishcloths.

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Stitch marker. Button.

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pm = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 64 sts.

1st row: (RS). K32. Pm. K32.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd row: Knit to 2 sts before marker. K2tog. Slip marker. ssk. Knit to end of row.

4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows.

6th row: (WS). Purl.

7th row: As 3rd row.

Rep 6th and 7th rows 6 times more.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times more.

Rep 6th and 7th rows 7 times more.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until 6 sts rem.

Cont as follows for Hanging Loop:

Hanging Loop: Knit every row (garter st) across rem 6 sts until loop measures 4½" [11.5 cm].

Next row: K2. Cast off 2 sts. K2.

Next row: K2. Cast on 2 sts. K2. Buttonhole made.

Knit 2 more rows.

Cast off.

Sew button on RS to correspond to buttonhole.
