



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =

Approximately

Beg = Begin(ing)

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

Kfb = Increase

1 stitch by knitting
into front and back of
next stitch

K2(3)tog = Knit next
2(3) stitches together

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

PssO = Pass slipped
stitch over

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch
knitwise

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 7" [18 cm] wide x 8½"
[21.5 cm] tall (excluding 'popsicle
stick').

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in
stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Dishcloth is worked using
'double knit' slip stitch technique..
Finished dishcloth will be double
thickness.

With A, cast on 30 sts.

1st row: (WS). *K1. Kfb. Rep from *
to end of row. 45 sts.

2nd row: K1. *Sl1. K1. Rep from *
to end of row.

3rd row: K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to
end of row.

Rep last 2 rows for pat until work
from beg measures 2½" [6 cm],
ending on a 3rd row. Break A.

Join B and cont even in pat
until work from beg measures
5" [12.5 cm]. Break B.

Join C and work 4 rows even in pat.

Shape top: 1st row: (RS). K1. Sl1.
K2tog. pssO. Pat to last 4 sts. K3tog.
K1.

2nd row: K1. *P1. K1. Rep from *
to end of row.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Hot Blue (01742) **1 ball or 10.5 yds/10 m**

Contrast B White (00001) **1 ball or 10.5 yds/10 m**

Contrast C Red (00095) **1 ball or 7 yds/7 m**

Contrast D Warm Brown (01130) **1 ball or 4 yds/4 m**

Note: 1 ball each of A, B, C and D will make approx 10 Dishcloths.

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles **or size needed to
obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.



Rep last 2 rows until there are 9 sts, ending on a WS row. Cast off knitwise (RS).

Popsicle Stick

With D, cast on 10 sts, beg with a purl row, work 3 rows reverse stocking st. Cast off purlwise (RS).

FINISHING

Sew Popsicle Stick to bottom of Dishcloth as shown in picture.
