

BERNAT® SHADOW BOX CROCHET BLANKET



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Vintage White (10006) **3 balls or 460 yds/418 m**

Contrast B Aquatic (10801) **3 balls or 460 yds/418 m**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Rem = Remain(ing)(s)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 44" x 58" [112 x 147.5 cm].

GAUGE

7 dc and 4 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- When working from chart, wind small balls of the colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate point. To change color, work to last loop on hook, then work "sl st in next ch-3 sp" with new color and proceed in next color.
- 1 square of the chart equals "Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st."
- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.

With A, ch 6. See Chart on page 2 and diagram on page 3.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of last 2 ch. Turn. 1 block.

2nd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch – beg block made. (Sl st. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp – block made. Turn. 2 blocks.

3rd row: Beg block. *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 3 blocks.

First 3 rows of chart are complete. Keeping cont of chart, rep last row until 24th row of chart is complete. 24 blocks.

Work sides even: Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows:

Next row: Sl st in each of first 3 dc. *Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Rep from * to end of row. **Turn.**

Next row: Ch 6. 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. *Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. Sl st in last ch-3 sp. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

Cont in chart, rep last 2 rows until 32nd row of chart is complete. 24 blocks.

Decrease corner: Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows:

Next row: Sl st in each of first 3 dc. *Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. Sl st in last ch-3 sp. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

Keeping cont of Chart, rep last row until 1 block rem. Fasten off.

Edging

Note: Turn at end of every rnd.

With **WS** facing, join B with sl st to corner indicated in chart.

1st rnd: (WS). With B, ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 3. *1 sc

between next 2 blocks. Ch 3.* Rep from * to * to next corner. (1 sc. Ch 3) twice in corner. Rep from * to * to next corner. 1 sc in corner sp. With A, (Ch 3. 1 sc. Ch 3) in same corner as last sc. With A, rep from * to * to next corner. (1 sc. Ch 3) twice in corner. Rep from * to * to last corner. 1 sc in last corner. Ch 3. Join with sl st to first sc. **Turn.**

2nd rnd: (RS). With A, sl st in first ch-3 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. *3 dc in next ch-3 sp.* Rep from * to * to next corner ch-3 sp. (3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp. Rep from * to * to next corner ch-3 sp. 3 dc in corner ch-3 sp. With B, ch 1. 3 dc in same ch-3 sp as last 3 dc. Rep from * to * to next corner ch-3 sp. (3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp. Rep from * to * to last corner ch-3 sp. 3 dc in corner ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. **Turn.**

3rd rnd: (WS). With B, sl st in corner ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 3. 1 sc in sp between next 2 groups of 3 dc.* Rep from * to * to next corner ch-1 sp. (Ch 3. 1 sc) twice in corner ch-1 sp. Rep from * to * to next corner ch-1 sp. 1 sc in corner ch-1 sp. With A, ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sc. With A, rep

from * to * to next corner ch-1 sp. (Ch 3. 1 sc) twice in corner ch-1 sp. Rep from * to * to last corner ch-1 sp. 1 sc in corner ch-1 sp. Ch 3. Join with sl st to first sc. **Turn.**

4th rnd: As 2nd rnd. Fasten off.
