## What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:** 4 balls each 1207 Cornsilk **A**, 1308 Tan **B**, 1601 Lettuce **C**, 1803 Blue Hawaii **D**, 1621 Evergreen **E**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 1 ripple = 5½" (14 cm)  
from peak to peak; 6 rows = 4"  
(10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
Use any size hook to obtain the  
gauge.

# 5-Color Radiating Ripple Throw

*This 5-color version of our popular ripple throw uses shades from the blue-green family with tan for contrast. Crochet it as shown, or choose your own unique combination of colors.*

SHOP KIT

Directions are for size **Small**. Changes for size **Large** are in parentheses.

Throw measures 36½ (47½)" [92.5 (120.5) cm] wide x 66½" long (167 cm).

## Notes

1. Throw is made in a ripple pattern which consists of a series of 3-dc "peaks" and dc3tog "valleys", with 6 dc worked between peaks and valleys. You may need to work several rows before the ripple is clearly visible.
2. Following color sequence, change color at beginning of each odd-numbered row.

## Special Stitch

**dc3tog** = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## Color Sequence

**A, B, C, D, E**


## THROW

With **A**, ch 116 (148).

**Row 1 (right side):** Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first dc), dc in next 6 ch, dc3tog, \*dc in next 6 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 6 ch, dc3tog; repeat from \* to last 7 ch, dc in next 6 ch, 2 dc in last ch, turn—113 (145) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts, dc3tog, \*dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts, dc3tog; repeat from \* across to last 7 sts, dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in top of beginning ch. Fasten off.

**Row 3:** With right side facing, join **B** with slip st in first st, ch 3, dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts, dc3tog, \*dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in next st,



dc in next 6 sts, dc3tog; repeat from \* across to last 7 sts, dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in top of beginning ch, turn.

**Row 4:** Repeat Row 2.

**Rows 5–100:** Repeat last 2 rows 48 times and change color as in the following color sequence: beginning with **C**, work 2 rows with each remaining color in sequence, [2 rows with each color in sequence] 9 times.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;  
**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
