



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50 x 60" [127 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

11 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 137 stitches (sts). **Do not** join. Working back and forth in rows, proceed as follows:
Work 4" [10 cm] in garter st (knit every row), noting 1st row is wrong side (WS) and ending on a WS row.

Proceed in pattern (pat) as follows:

1st row: (Right side - RS). Knit (K)11. Place marker (PM). K115. PM. K11.

2nd row: Knit to marker. Slip marker. *K1. Slip next stitch knitwise (Sl1). Repeat (rep) from * to 1 st before marker. K1. Slip marker. Knit to end of row.

3rd row: Knit.

4th row: Knit to marker. Slip marker. K2. *Sl1. K1. Rep from * to 1 st before marker. K1. Slip marker. Knit to end of row.

5th row: Knit.
Rep 2nd to 5th rows for pat until work from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 56" [142 cm], ending on a 3rd or 5th row.

Work 4" [10 cm] in garter st, ending on a RS row. Cast off knitwise (WS).

MATERIALS

Bernat® Maker Home Dec™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 317 yds/290 m)

Clay (11008)

5 balls or 1400 yds/1280 m

Size U.S. 15 (10 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 2 stitch markers.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

K = Knit

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side
