18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " 10 cm ] in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Stripe Pat

With MC, work 10 rows stocking st. With A, work 2 rows stocking st. These 12 rows form Stripe Pat.

## BACK

With smaller needles and A, cast on 80 (88-95-104-118-135) sts. Knit 9 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS and inc 5 (5-6-7-7-8) sts evenly across last row. 85 (93-101-111-125-143) sts. Break A.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx $17 \frac{1}{2}$ [ 44.5 cm ], ending with 10 rows of MC.

Shape raglans: With A, cast off 2 (2-3-3-4-4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 81 (89-95-105-117-135) sts.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

Sizes $2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 \mathrm{XL}$ only: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
Rep last 2 rows (4-14) times more, then 1st row once. (95-73) sts. Purl 1 row.

Sizes M, L, XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows (1-1-5-3-2) time(s) more. (77-83-69-71-55) sts.

All sizes: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 23 (21-23-16-16-8) times more. Leave rem 33 (33-35-35-37-37) sts on a st holder.

## LEFT FRONT

**With smaller needles and $A$, cast on 40 (44-48-53-59-68) sts.
Knit 9 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS and inc 3 (3-3-3-4-4) sts evenly across last row. 43 (47-51-56-63-72) sts.**

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures same length as Back before armholes, ending with 10 rows of MC.

Shape raglan: 1st row: (RS). With A, cast off 2 (2-3-3-4-4) sts. Knit to end of row. 41 (45-48-53-5968) sts.

2nd row: With A, purl.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

Size XS/S only: Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
2nd row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. 27 sts rem.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 6 times more. 6 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). K2. ssk. K2tog.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2. ssk.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Sizes M, L and XL only: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.

Shape neck: 1 st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. 2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
Rep last 4 rows (0-0-1) time(s) more. (38-41-41) sts rem.

Sizes $M$ and $L$ only: 1 st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

## 2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (3033) sts rem.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

## 4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows (7-8) times more. 6 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). K2. ssk. K2tog.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2. ssk.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Size XL only: 1 st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

## 2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.

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4th row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
Rep last 4 rows twice more. 29 sts rem.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to end of row. 4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 7 times more. 5 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). K2. ssk. K1.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2. ssk.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Sizes $2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 \mathrm{XL}$ only:
1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (5160) sts.

Size 4/5XL only: Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
2nd row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.

Rep last 2 rows 8 times more. 33 sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
4th row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 17 sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to end
of row.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 5 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). K2. ssk. K1.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2. ssk.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Size 2/3XL only: Shape neck:
1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
2nd row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 31 sts
rem.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
2nd row: Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl P2.
3rd row: K2. ssk. Knit to end of row.
4th row: Purl.
5th row: As 1st row.
6th row: Purl.
7th row: As 3rd row.
8th row: Purl.
Rep 5th to 8th rows 7 times more.
3 sts rem.

Next row: ssk. K1.
Next row: P2.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Left Front.
Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures same length as Back to raglans, ending with 1 row of $A$.

Shape raglan: 1 st row: (WS). With A, cast off 2 (2-3-3-4-4) sts. Purl to end of row. 41 (45-48-53-59-68) sts.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

Size XS/S only: Shape neck:
1st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 6 times more. 27 sts rem.

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 6 times more. 6 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). ssk. K2tog. K2.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2tog. K2.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Sizes $\mathrm{M}, \mathrm{L}$ and XL only: 1 st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

Shape neck: 1 st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

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Rep last 4 rows (0-0-1) time(s) more. (38-41-41) sts rem.

Sizes $M$ and $L$ only: 1 st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2. 2nd row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (3033) sts rem.

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows ( $7-8$ ) times more. 6 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). ssk. K2tog. K2.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2tog. K2.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Size XL only: 1 st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

Rep last 4 rows twice more. 29 sts rem.
1st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 7 times more. 5 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). K1. K2tog. K2.
Next row: P4.
Next row: K2tog. K2.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Sizes $2 / 3 X L$ and 4/5XL only: 1st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows 3 times more. (5160) sts.

Size 4/5XL only: Shape neck:
1st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows 8 times more. 33 sts.

1 st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. 1 st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts.
K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.
Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 17 sts.
1 st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: Purl.
Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 5 sts rem.

Next row: (RS). K1. K2tog. K2.
Next row: P4
Next row: K2tog. K2.
Next row: P3.
Next row: K3tog. Fasten off.
Size 2/3XL only: Shape neck:
1st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to last 4 sts.
K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of
row.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Purl
Rep last 4 rows 3 times more. 31 sts rem.

K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to end of row.
3rd row: Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
4th row: Purl.
5th row: As 1st row.
6th row: Purl.
7th row: As 3rd row.
8th row: Purl.
Rep 5th to 8th rows 7 times more.
3 sts rem
Next row: K1. K2tog.
Next row: P2.
Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles and $A$, cast on 38 (38-42-42-46-46) sts.
Knit 9 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS and inc 3 sts evenly across last row. 41 (41-45-45-49-49) sts.

Change to larger needles and work 6 rows in Stripe Pat.
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, inc 1 st each end of next row and following 6th (4th-4th-4th-4th-4th) rows until there are 67 (59-63-81-83-85) sts.

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Sizes $M$ and LL only: Inc 1 st each end of next row and following 6th rows until there are (73-77) sts.

All sizes: Cont even in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx $171 / 2(171 / 2-17112-17112-151 / 2$ 151/2)" [44.5 (44.5-44.5-44.5-39.5$39.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending with 10 rows of MC.

Shape raglans: With A, cast off 2 (2-3-3-4-4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 63 (69-71-75-75-77) sts.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.

## 4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows 2 (3-2-2-0-1) time(s) more. 45 (45-53-57-69-65) sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.
2nd row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows 17 (17-21-22-2826) times more. Leave rem 9 (9-9-11-11-11) sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Sew raglan seams. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Front and neckband: With RS facing, A and circular needle, pick up and knit 74 sts up Right Front to V-neck shaping, 42 (45-45-47-49-51) sts up V-neck edge. K9 (9-9-11-11-11) from Right Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at center. K33 (33-35-35-37-37) from Back st holder, dec 2 sts evenly across. K9 (9-9-11-11-11) from Left Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit 42 (45-45-47-49-51) sts down V-neck edge and 74 sts down Left Front. 279 (285-287-295-301305) sts. Do not join.

Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 6 rows (garter st).
Cast off knitwise (WS).
