



## MATERIALS

**Coats & Clark Dual Duty XP® All-purpose Thread**

**Coats & Clark Dual Duty Plus Hand Quilting Thread**

1/8 yard (.11m) or scraps of five different light or medium weight fabrics

1/4 yard (.23m) cotton fabric for backing

Cotton batting

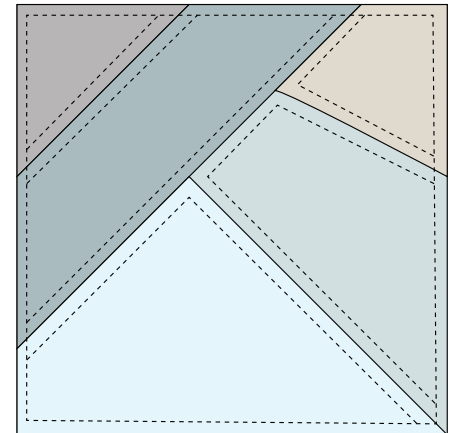
Make these fun coasters in an afternoon, from scraps you already have on hand! Choose five different fabrics to match your décor. Accent with hand quilting using Coats & Clark Hand Quilting threads.

## MEASUREMENTS

4 1/2" x 4 1/2" (11.43cm x 11.43cm)

## CUTTING

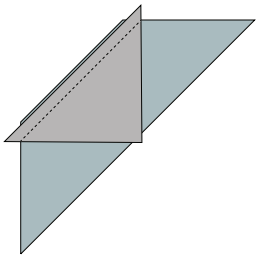
- Using the pattern given, cut out the five pieces in five different fabrics.
- Cut one 5" x 5" (12.70cm x 12.70cm) square backing fabric for each coaster
- Cut one 5" x 5" (12.70cm x 12.70cm) square batting for each coaster



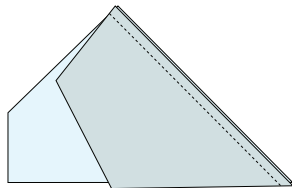
## SEWING

Use ¼" (.635cm) seam allowances.

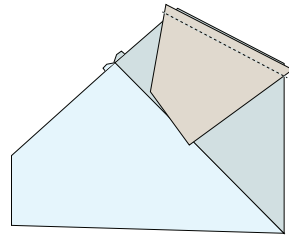
1. Thread with Coats Dual Duty all-purpose thread top and bobbin. Sew A to B as shown.



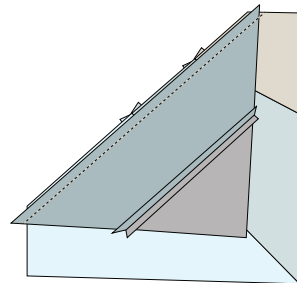
2. Sew C to D as shown.



3. Add E as shown.



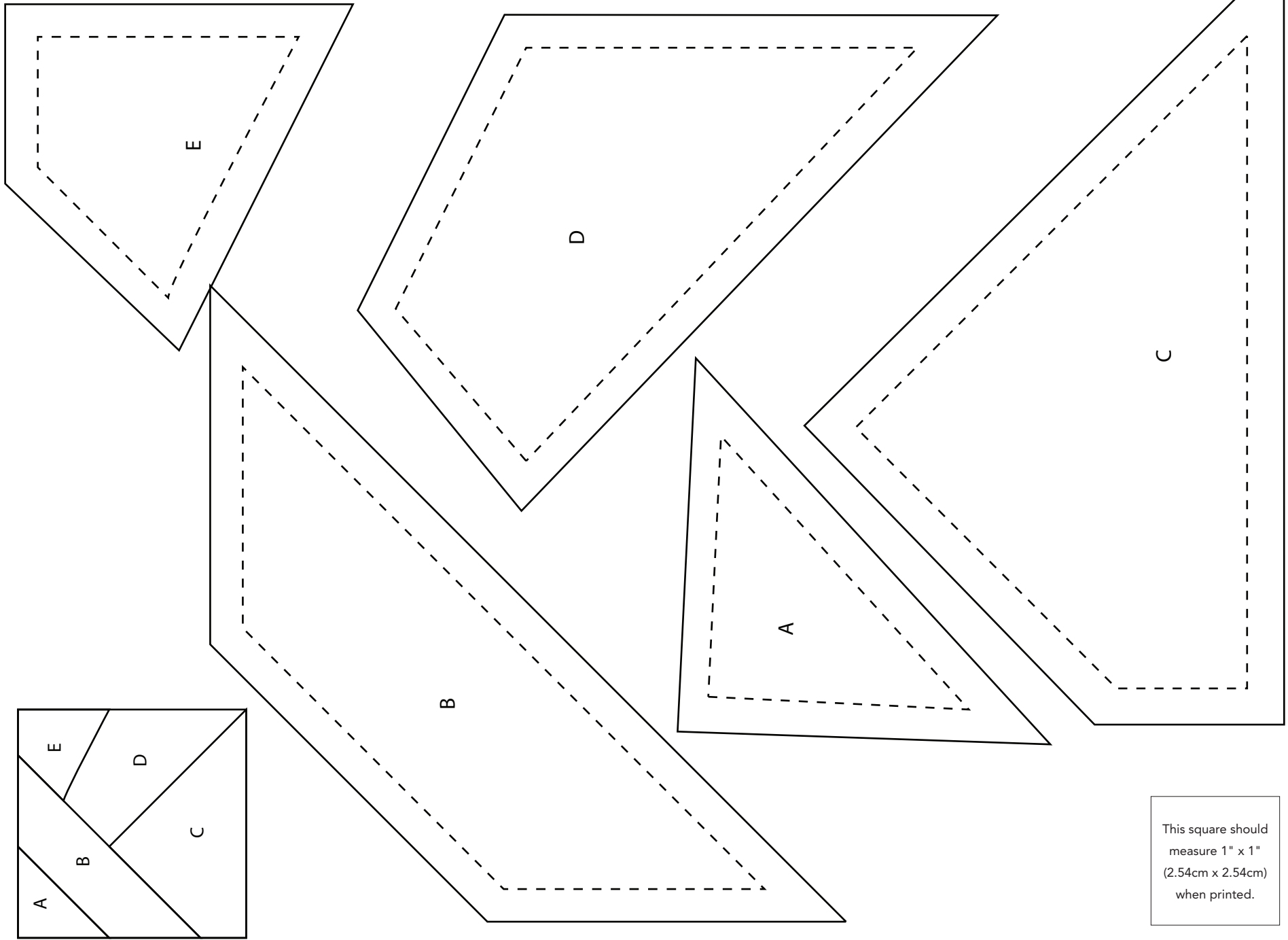
4. Add A/B as shown.



5. Press the seams open.
6. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, trim the coaster top piece to 5" x 5" (12.70cm x 12.70cm).
7. Place the pieced top and backing right sides together on top of batting.
8. Stitch all the way around leaving a 2" (5.08cm) opening for turning.

9. Clip the corners, turn and press.
10. Hand sew the opening closed.
11. Hand or machine quilt next to the seams.





This square should measure 1" x 1" (2.54cm x 2.54cm) when printed.
