



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Beg = Beginning

Dec = Decrease(ing)

K = Knit

K1tbl = Knit next stitch through back loop only

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of stitch

P = Purl

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

SIZES

Adult **S/M** (**L/XL**)

GAUGE

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

Right Glove

With set of smaller double-pointed needles, cast on **42 (**48**) sts.

Divide sts evenly on 3 needles, having **14** (**16**) sts on each needle. Join in rnd. PM on first st.

1st rnd: *K1tbl. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for 4" [10 cm].

Change to larger set of needles and knit 7 rnds.**

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: **K22** (**25**). (Kfb) twice. Knit to end of rnd. **44** (**50**) sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: **K22** (**25**). Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. **46** (**52**) sts.

5th rnd: **K22** (**25**). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. **48** (**54**) sts.

7th rnd: **K22** (**25**). Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. **50** (**56**) sts.

MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool Worsted™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 210 yds/192 m)

Sizes	S/M	L/XL	
Plum Heather (77307)	1	1	ball

Set of 4 sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and U.S. 6 (4 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Stitch marker. Safety pin.

9th rnd: K22 (25). Kfb. K8. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 52 (58) sts.

11th rnd: K22 (25). Kfb. K10. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 54 (60) sts.

13th rnd: K36 (39). Slip last 14 sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd.

*****14th rnd:** Knit to end of rnd, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. 42 (48) sts.

Knit in rnds until work after ribbing measures 4 (4½)" [10 (11.5) cm], dec 2 sts evenly across last rnd. 40 (46) sts.

Next rnd: *K1tbl. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for 1½ (2)" [4 (5) cm]. Cast off in ribbing.

Thumb: With RS facing, join yarn to base of thumb, pick up and knit 2 sts. K14 from safety pin. Divide these 16 sts onto 3 needles (5, 5, 6).

Work 3 rnds of (K1tbl. P1) ribbing. Cast off in ribbing.***

Left Glove

Work from ** to ** as given for Right Glove.

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K18 (21). (Kfb) twice. Knit to end of rnd. 44 (50) sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: K18 (21). Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 46 (52) sts.

5th rnd: K18 (21). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 48 (54) sts.

7th rnd: K18 (21). Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 50 (56) sts.

9th rnd: K18 (21). Kfb. K8. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 52 (58) sts.

11th rnd: K18 (21). Kfb. K10. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 54 (60) sts.

13th rnd: K32 (35). Slip last 14 sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd.

Work from *** to *** as given for Right Glove.
