


### MATERIALS

Caron® Big Donut O'Go® (9.9 oz/280 g; 502 yds/459 m)

Sizes	XS/S/M	L/XL	2/3XL	4/5XL	O'Gos
Blue Moon (29018)	2	3	4	4	O'Gos
Choco-Blueberry (29010)	2	3	4	4	O'Gos



Size U.S. 8 [5 mm] knitting needles. Size U.S. 7 [4.5 mm] circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle. **5 (5-6-6)** buttons 1" [2.5 cm] in diameter. Locking stitch marker.

### SIZES

#### To fit bust measurement

#### Finished bust measurement

<b>XS/S/M</b>	<b>45" [110 cm]</b>
<b>L/XL</b>	<b>51" [129.5 cm]</b>
<b>2/3XL</b>	<b>57" [145 cm]</b>
<b>4/5XL</b>	<b>65" [134.5 cm]</b>

### GAUGES

16 sts and 30 rows = 4" in garter st.  
 17 sts and 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Notes

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.

- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H and I). Note that Contrast D is in both Blue Moon and Choco-Blueberry O'Gos. You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H and I.
- Cardigan is worked in patchwork squares joined together as shown in diagrams for Back, Fronts and Sleeves.
- Ribbing, button bands and collar are worked during finishing

### Solid Garter Stitch Blocks (make 6 each in B, E and I).

With pair of needles, cast on **22 (25-28-32)** sts.

Work in garter st (knit every row), noting 1st row is WS, until work from beg measures **5½ (6-6½-6½)" [14 (15-16.5-16.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Cast off knitwise (RS).

### Striped Garter Stitch Blocks (make 5)

With G and pair of needles, cast on **22 (25-28-32)** sts.

Knit 3 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS.

With F, knit 2 rows.

With G, knit 2 rows.

Rep last 4 rows until work from beg measures **5½ (6-6½-6½)" [14 (15-16.5-16.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise (RS).

### Moss Stitch Blocks (make 6 each in A and C)

With pair of needles, cast on **22 (26-28-32)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** As 1st row.

**3rd row:** \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**4th row:** As 3rd row.

Rep last 4 rows until work from beg measures **5½ (6-6½-6½)" [14 (15-16.5-16.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise (RS).


### Houndstooth Blocks (make 5).

**Note:** When working from chart, carry yarn not in use loosely across WS of work, but never over more than 3 sts. When it must pass over more than 3 sts, weave it over and under color in use on next st or at center point of sts it passes over. The colors are never twisted around one another.

With A and pair of needles, cast on, cast on **24 (28-32-36)** sts.

Work Chart in stocking st, *reading knit rows from right to left and purl rows from left to right*, noting 4-st rep will be worked **6 (7-8-9)** times, until work from beg measures approx **5½ (6-6½-6½)" [14 (15-16.5-16.5) cm]**, ending on Row 4 of chart.

With H, cast off knitwise (RS).



### Broken Rib Squares (make 5 each in H and G).

With pair of needles, cast on **23 (25-31-35)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). Knit.

**2nd row:** K1. \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures **5½ (6-6½-6½)" [14 (15-16.5-16.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise (RS).

### Collar

With C and circular needle, cast on **94 (102-110-110)** sts. **Do not** join. Work back and forth across needle in rows as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing for 8" [20.5 cm].

Cast off in rib.

## Cuff Ribbing

With F and circular needle, cast on **70 (74-82-94)** sts. **Do not** join.

Work back and forth across needle in rows as follows:

Work in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Collar for 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Cast off in rib.

## Bottom Ribbing

With D and circular needle, cast on **190 (214-238-272)** sts. **Do not** join.

Work back and forth across needle in rows as follows:

Work in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Collar for 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Cast off in rib.

## Buttonhole Band

With D and circular needle cast on **102 (110-124-124)** sts. **Do not** join.

Work back and forth across needle in rows as follows:

Work in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Collar for 1" [2.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

**Buttonhole row:** (RS). K2. Cast off next 2 sts. \*Rib next **22 (24-22-22)** sts. Cast off next 2 sts. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**Next row:** Work in (K2. P2) ribbing, casting on 2 sts over cast off sts.

Cont in (K2. P2) ribbing until Band measures 2" [5 cm].

Cast off in rib.

## Button Band

Work as given for Buttonhole Band, omitting references to buttonholes.


## Finishing

Following Assembly Diagrams on page 4, with WS facing each other, sew Motifs tog, using mattress st.


Place markers **6 (7-8-10)" [15 (18-20.5-25.5)** cm] in from side edges of Fronts and Back for shoulders.

Sew shoulder seams. Sew Collar around neck edge.


Place markers at sides of Fronts and Back for Sleeves **8¼ (9¼-10½-12)" [21 (23.5-25.5-30.5)** cm] down from shoulders. Sew in sleeves between markers. Sew Cuff Ribbing to end of Sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew Bottom Ribbing to lower edge of Cardigan. Sew buttonhole and button band to front edge of Cardigan, making note of which side you want buttons and buttonholes on, respectively. Sew buttons onto button band to correspond to buttonholes.








RIGHT FRONT
