



CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MEASUREMENTS

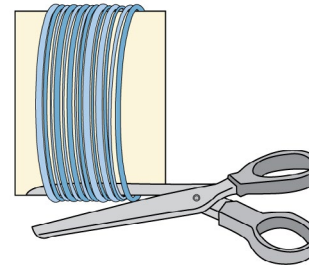
Approx 15" x 20" [38 x 51 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Make latch yarn pieces: Wrap yarn around a 2¼" [5.5 cm] piece of cardboard. Cut across one end to make 4½" [11.5 cm] total length pieces of yarn.

You will need:

Contrast A - 2082 pieces.
 Contrast B - 296 pieces.
 Contrast C - 296 pieces.
 Contrast D - 296 pieces.
 Contrast E - 296 pieces.



With cut yarn and latch tool, (see diagrams on page 2) work Wall Hanging following Chart on page 3 noting grid is 46 squares wide x 71 squares long. Trim ends carefully as needed.

Tip: Work Contrast B, C, D and E sections first. Work Contrast A sections last.

Edge Finishing:

See diagrams on page 2
 With 2 strands of A and yarn needle, finish all 4 edges of Wall Hanging as follows:

1. Trim evenly around edges of work leaving 2 squares fully intact. Trim and remove corners.
2. Fold unfinished edges to wrong side of work.
3. With needle and 2 strands of yarn held together, whip stitch around unfinished squares, working down and around unfinished edge on right side of work. When whip-stitching around each 4th set of squares, also work under one strand on wrong side of canvas to secure folded edge in place.
4. Tie off strands to secure and weave in ends.
5. Cut 6" [15.5 cm] for hanging loop.
6. Tie ends of hanging loop to center top of back of Wall Hanging.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Forever Fleece™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 177 yds/194 m)

Contrast A White Noise (61004) **2 balls**

Contrast B Rolling Sky (61043) **1 ball**

Contrast C Rose Hip (61003) **1 ball**

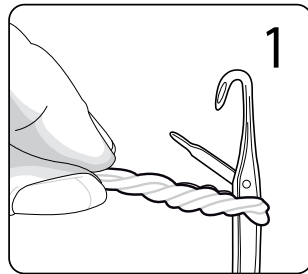
Contrast D Clay (61048) **1 ball**

Contrast E Seaglass (61049) **1 ball**

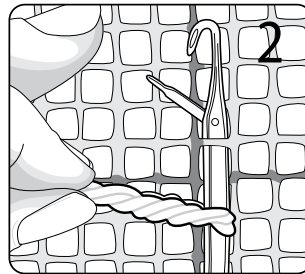
Latch hook tool. Yarn needle. 19" x 24" [48.5 x 61 cm] piece of latch canvas. 2¼" [5.5 cm] wide piece of cardboard. Masking tape (optional).

HOW TO LATCH

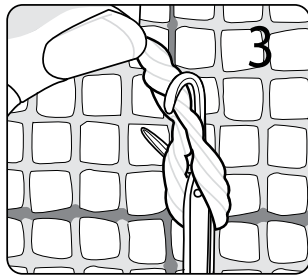
Tip: Cover the edges of your canvas with masking tape to prevent snagging. This can be removed when you are finished.



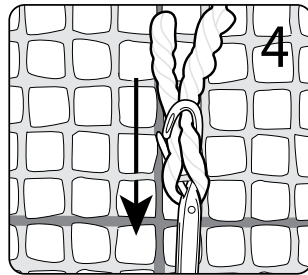
1. Wrap yarn around tool below the latch, keeping it folded evenly.



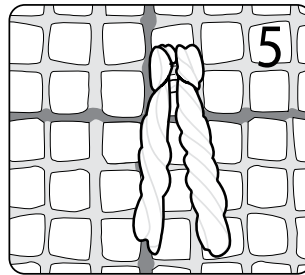
2. Insert tool through canvas as shown



3. Place yarn between latch and hook and pull tool towards you to close latch

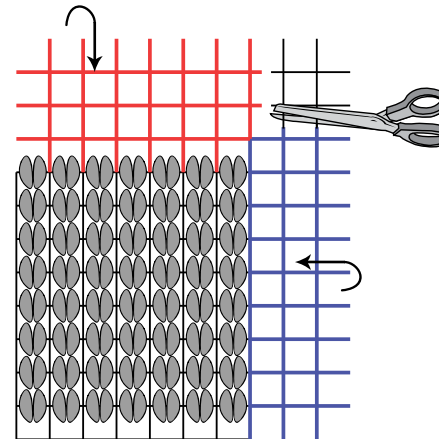


4. Let go of yarn ends and pull tool back through holes to complete knot.

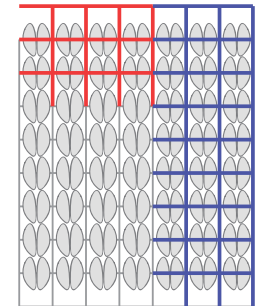


5. Tug yarn ends evenly to tighten knot.

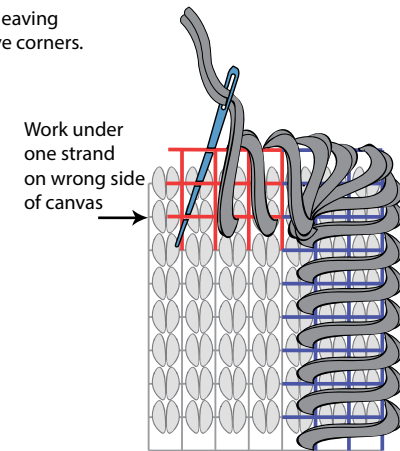
EDGE FINISHING



1. Trim evenly around edges of work leaving 2 squares fully intact. Trim and remove corners.



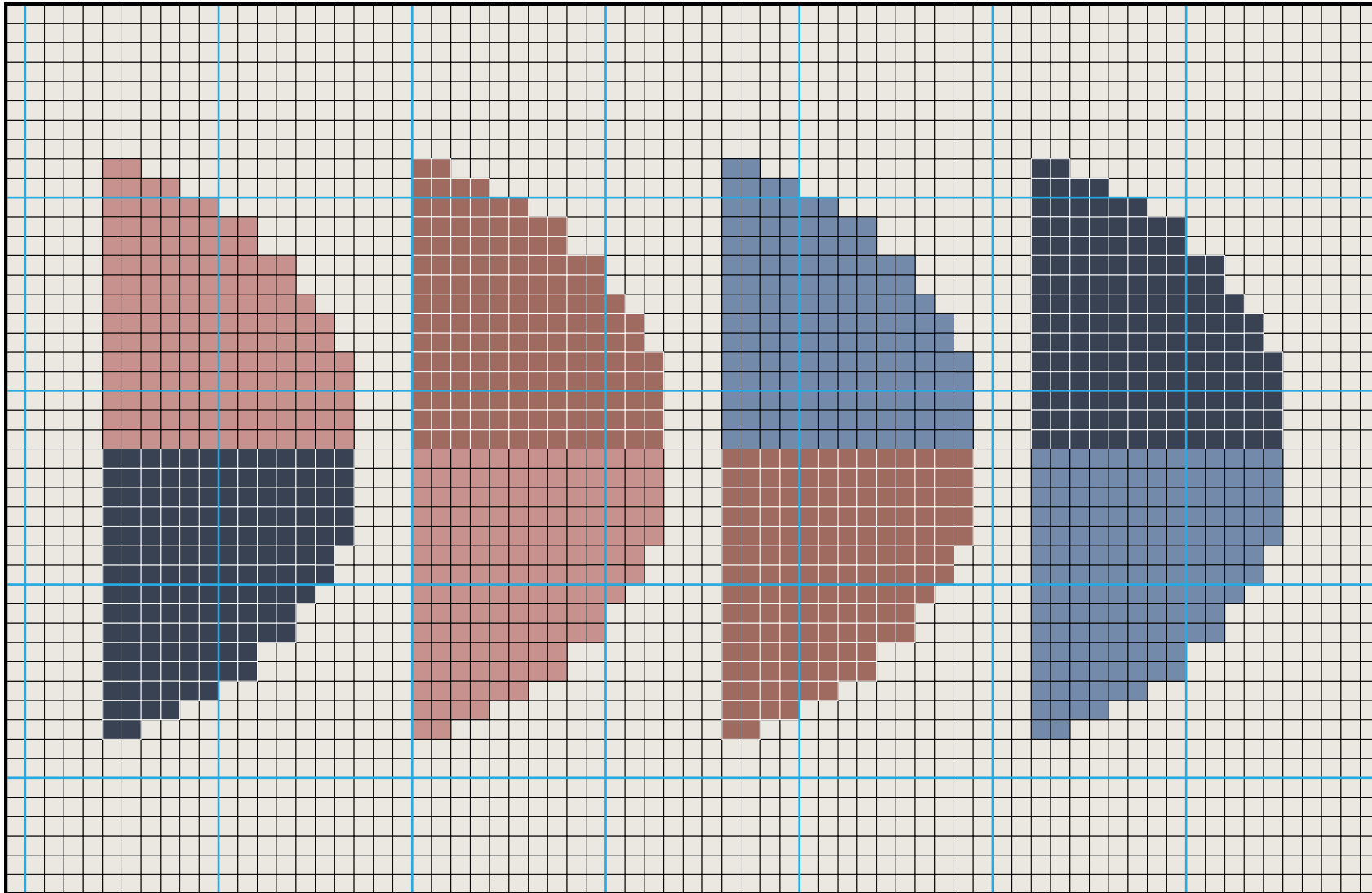
2. Fold unfinished squares to wrong side of work.



Work under one strand on wrong side of canvas

3. With needle and 2 strands of yarn held together, whip stitch around unfinished squares, working down and around unfinished edge on right side of work. When whip stitching around each 4th set of squares, also work under one strand on wrong side of canvas to secure folded edge in place.

4. Tie off strands to secure and weave in ends.
