

BERNAT® BIG BASKETWEAVE BLANKET | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) or 5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)
Mallard Wood (10203) or (00203) **1035 yds/940 m or 5 (10) balls**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly) **Pat** = Pattern
Beg = Begin(ing) **Rep** = Repeat(ing)
Cont = Continue(ity) **St(s)** = Stitch(es)
K = Knit **WS** = Wrong side
P = Purl

 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 56" x 60" [142 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 112 sts. **Do not** join. *Working back and forth across needles in rows,* knit 8 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (WS). K8. *P8. K8. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd to 12th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows 5 times more.

13th row: K8. *K8. P8. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K8.

14th row: Knit.

15th to 24th rows: As 13th and 14th rows 5 times more.

Last 24 rows form Basketweave Pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 58" [147.5 cm], ending on a 12th or 24th row of pat.

Knit 8 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).
