## Santa Scrubby Mitt

*Crochet this Scrubby for a jolly host/hostess gift or stocking stuffer! It's great for protecting your holiday manicure whether you use it in the kitchen or bath.*

### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby™:** 1 ball each 10 Coconut **A**, 215 Bamboo **B**, 905 Cherry **C**, and 715 Primrose **D**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5mm [US H-8]

Tapestry needle, sewing needle and white thread, ½ yd black worsted weight yarn

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



**RED HEART® Scrubby™**, Art. E833 available in solids 3.5 oz (100 g), 92 yd (85 m) and prints 3 oz (85 g), 78 yd (71 m) balls

SHOP KIT

**Mitt measures 5½" (14 cm) across face x 8½" (21.5 cm) long, excluding hanging loop.**

### Special Stitch

**sc2tog** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### NOTES

1. Scrubby is made from front and back pieces worked in turned rows and sewn together.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

### MITT

#### FRONT

#### Ribbed Cuff

With **A**, ch 8.

**Row 1 (right side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—7 sc.

**Rows 2–16:** Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across, turn.

#### Beard

**Row 1 (right side):** Ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc in each row across, turn—16 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn—18 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Repeat Row 3 until piece measures 3½" (9 cm) from bottom edge of ribbed cuff; change to **B** at end of last row.

#### Face

Repeat Row 3 until piece measures 4¾" (12 cm) from bottom edge of ribbed cuff; change to **A** at end of last row.

Repeat Row 3 three times; leaving a long beginning tail for sewing, change to **C** at end of last row.

#### Hat

**Rows 1 and 2:** Repeat Row 3 of beard.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog, turn—16 sc.

**Row 4:** Repeat Row 3 of beard.

**Rows 5–12:** Repeat last 2 rows 4 times—8 sc at end of Row 12.

**Rows 13 and 14:** Ch 1, [sc2tog] across, turn—2 sc at end of Row 14. Fasten off.

#### BACK

Work same as front, omitting all color changes except **C** for hat.

#### Mustache

With **A**, ch 10.

**Row 1 (right side):** Slip st in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, 3 dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, slip st in next ch, hdc in next ch, slip st in last ch. Fasten off.

#### Nose

With **D**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

#### Hanging Loop

With **A**, ch 10; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 1, 12 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

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## FINISHING

Refer to photograph as a guide for placement of facial features.

With sewing needle and thread, sew mustache to center of face above beard and sew nose to head above mustache.

With black yarn, embroider satin stitch eye on each side of nose on face.

Taking care to match colors and leaving bottom edge open for wearer's hand, sew front and back together with **A**-colored across side edges of cuff, beard, and face and with **C**-colored tails across side edges of hat. With end tail, sew hanging loop to top point of hat.

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
