What you will need:

RED HEART® Baby Hugs™
Medium: 1 ball per Bib: 4955 Pollywog, 4820 Sky

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6.0mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sc and 14 rows sc = 4" [10 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Crochet Baby Bibs

These handy crochet bibs are appreciated by busy parents! The premium acrylic yarn is completely machine wash and dry and has been Oeko-Tex tested and certified free from harmful levels of over 300 substances.

Directions are for size 0-3 months. Changes for sizes 3-6 months and 6-12 months are in parentheses.

Baby Bib measures: About 8½" long (from top neck band edge to bottom point) x 9" wide (at widest point) [21 cm x 23 cm].

Special Stitch

sc2tog = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NECK RIBBING

Ch 4 (5, 5).

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; turn—3 (4, 4) sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in back loop of each sc across; turn.

Rows 3-45 (51, 54): Repeat Row 2. At end of last Row, do not turn; fasten off.

BIB

Row 1 (Right Side): Skip first 15 (17, 17) side Rows of Ribbing and join yarn. Ch 1, sc in same side Row, 2 sc in next side Row, sc in next 13 (15, 17) side Rows; turn—16 (18, 20) sc.

Rows 2-5 (2-7, 2-8): Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in remaining sc across; turn—20 (24, 27) sc.

Rows 6-10 (8-12, 9-14): Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

Rows 11-28 (13-34, 15-39): Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc2tog, sc in remaining sc across; turn—2 (2, 2) sc.

Row 29 (35, 40): Ch 1, sc2tog; fasten off.



ASSEMBLY

Seam beginning and ending Neck Ribbing Rows together. Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[]** = work direction in brackets the number of times specified; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
