## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Handicrafter Cotton ${ }^{\circledR}$ ( $1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{~g} ; 80 \mathrm{yds} / 73 \mathrm{~m}$ )
BATH POUF
Robin's Egg (01215) $\quad 2$ balls or $\mathbf{1 2 5}$ yds [114 m]
Size U.S. I/9 ( 5.5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

## FLORAL FACECLOTHS

## VERSION 1:

Main Color (MC) Robin's Egg (01215) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{5 0} \mathbf{y d s}$ [ $\mathbf{4 5} \mathbf{~ m}$ ]
Contrast A White (01001) 1 ball or $\mathbf{3 5}$ yds [32 m]
VERSION 2:
Main Color (MC) White (01001) 1 ball or $\mathbf{5 0}$ yds [45 m]
Contrast A Robin's Egg (01215) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{3 5}$ yds [32 m]
Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## STASH BASKET

Robin's Egg (01215) $\quad \mathbf{3}$ balls or $\mathbf{3 0 0} \mathbf{y d s}$ [ $\mathbf{2 7 5} \mathbf{~ m}$ ]
Size U.S. E/4 ( 3.5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## BATH MITT

Robin's Egg (01215) 2 balls or 92 yds [84 m] Size U.S. 7 ( 4.5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## SCRUBBY

White (01001) or Robin's Egg (01215) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{4 5}$ yds [ $\mathbf{4 0} \mathbf{~ m}$ ]
Size U.S. G/6 ( 4 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Small sponge approx 3" 7.5 cm ] x 4" [10 cm] to insert inside Scrubby.

## BATH POUF



## MEASUREMENT

Approx 6" [15 cm] diameter.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 5. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring. Ch 40 for hanging loop and sl st back into ring.
1st rnd: Ch 1. Work 25 sc in ch-5 ring. Join with sl st to first sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 3 (does not count as st). 3 dc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first dc. 75 dc .
3rd rnd: Ch 3 (does not count as st). 3 dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first dc. 225 dc .
4th rnd: Ch 3 (does not count as st). 3 dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first dc. 675 dc . Fasten off.

## FLORAL FACECLOTHS



## MEASUREMENT

Approx 10 " $[25.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in diameter.

## GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 does not count as hdc in 1st to 3rd rnds.
With MC, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 2.10 hdc in ring. Join with sl st to first hdc.
2nd rnd: Ch 2.2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 20 hdc.
3rd rnd: Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 40 hdc.
4th rnd: Ch 2. (1 hdc. Ch 1.2 hdc) in same sp as sl st. *Skip next 2 hdc. (2 hdc. Ch 1.2 hdc) in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2.

5th rnd: Sl st in next st and ch-1 sp. Ch 2. (1 hdc. Ch 1.2 hdc) in same ch-1 sp. *(2 hdc. Ch 1.2 hdc) in next ch-1 sp - shell made. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch 2.
6th and 7th rnds: SI st in next st and ch-1 sp. Ch 2. (2 hdc. Ch 1. 3 hdc) in same ch-1 sp. *(3 hdc. Ch 1.3 hdc) in next ch- 1 sp . Rep from *around. Join A with sl st to top of ch 2 at end of 7 th rnd.
8th rnd: With A, ch 2. *8 dc in next ch- 1 sp . 1 sc in sp between 2 shells. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first dc.
9th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. Ch 1. (1 sc in next dc. Ch 1) 7 times. *( 1 sc in sp between next 2 shells 1 row below. Ch 1) 4 times. 1 sc in same ch-1 sp as last sc. (Ch 1.1 sc in sp between next 2 shells 1 row above) 3 times.** ( 1 sc in next dc. Ch 1) 8 times. Rep from * 11 times more, then from * to ${ }^{* *}$ once. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

## STASH BASKET



## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $5 \times 10 \times 6$ " $12.5 \times 25.5 \times$ 15 cm ].

## GAUGE

18 sc and 20 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for small basket. If changes are necessary for medium basket the instructions will be written thus ().

## Sides

Ch 28.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 27 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc across. Turn.
Rep last row until work from beg measures 5 " [ 12.5 cm ], ending with a WS row.

Next row: (RS). (Fold line). Ch 1. Rep last row until work from beg Working through back loops only, 1 sc in each sc across. Turn.
***Next row: Ch 1. Working through both loops, 1 sc in each sc across. Turn.
Rep last row until work from last fold line measures 10 " [ 25.5 cm ], ending with a WS row.***
Next row: (RS). (Fold line). Ch 1. Working through back loops only, 1 sc in each sc across. Turn.
Next row: Ch 1. Working through both loops, 1 sc in each sc across. Turn.
Rep last row until work from last fold line measures $5^{\prime \prime}[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending with a WS row.
Rep from *** to *** once more. Next row: (RS). (Joining row). Place foundation ch behind last row with WS of work tog. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, 1 sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

## Base

Ch 46.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 45 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc across. Turn.
measures 5 " [ 12.5 cm ], ending with a WS row. Do not fasten off.

Join Base to Sides: Place lower edge of Sides behind Base with WS of work tog, aligning corners of Base with fold lines and joining row of Sides.
Next rnd: (RS). Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, work 1 rnd of $s c$ around all 4 sides of Base. Join with $s l$ st in first $s c$. Fasten off.

## BATH MITT



## SIZE

One size to fit adult.

## GAUGE

14 sc and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 34.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. 33 sts. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row 6 times more.
Shape thumb gusset: 1 st row: (RS). Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in each of next 2 sts .1 sc in each $s t$ to end of row. Turn.
2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th
rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
7th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
9th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 8 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

11th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 10 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
13th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 17 sts. Ch 2 . Skip next 14 sts. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
14th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st or ch 1 sp to end of row. 33 sts. Cont even until work from beg measures 8 " [20.5 cm ] ending with a WS row.

Shape top: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1.1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts . Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts . Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Fasten off.

Thumb: With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to ch sp. Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 ch .1 sc in each of next 14 sts . Join with sl st to first sc. 16 sc . Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Rep last rnd 4 times more.
Next rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 8 times. Join with sl st to first st. 8 sts.
Next rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 4 times. 4 sts. Fasten off. Thread end through a tapestry needle and draw yarn through rem sts. Fasten securely.

SCRUBBY


## MEASUREMENT

Approx 5" [12.5 cm] long.

## GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Front and Back

(make 2 pieces alike)
Ch 22.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch . Turn. 21 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts .1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
4th row: As 2nd row.
5th row: As 3rd row.
6th and 7th rows: As 2nd row. 11 sts rem at end of 7 th row.
8th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Sc2tog. Turn. 8 sts rem.
9th and 10th rows: As 2nd row. 4 sts rem at end of 10th row. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to second loop of foundation ch.
1st row: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 18 ch . Turn. 19 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.

3rd row: As 2nd row.
4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
6th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
7th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Sc3tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Sc2tog. Turn. 7 sts rem.
8th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Sc2tog. Turn.
9th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog over first 2 sts. 1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. 3 sts rem.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With WS of pieces tog, join yarn with sl st to bottom. Working through both thicknesses, work sc to tip, work 3 sc in tip. Insert sponge, cutting sponge to shape if necessary. Cont working sc along other side to end of rnd. Ch 9 (loop). Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
