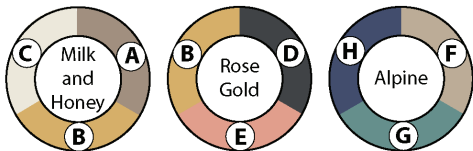
ABBREVIATIONS

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ O'Go™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Milk and Honey (42005)	2 O'Gos
Rose Gold (42019)	1 O'Go
Alpine (42016)	2 O'Gos



Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
T-pins 1¾" [4.5 cm]. Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 49¾" x 58½" [126 x 148.5 cm].

GAUGE

7 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in
garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Easily separate colors by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Start knitting!

- Contrast B is in both Milk and Honey and Rose Gold O'Gos.
- Blanket is made of 5 Panels seamed together in Finishing (see diagram on page 3).
- Cast on each Panel with long-tail cast on method.

STRIPE PATS (See Assembly & Color diagram on page 3)

Stripe Pat 1 (Main Panel 1)

Work 26 rows each with: B, G, H, B, G, E, B, H, and D.
These 234 rows form Stripe Pat.

Stripe Pat 2 (Main Panel 2)

Work 26 rows each with: D, H, B, E, G, B, H, G, and B.
These 234 rows form Stripe Pat.

Stripe Pat 3 (Left Panel)

With A, work 14 rows.
*With F, work 26 rows.
With A, work 26 rows.
Rep from * 3 times more.
With F, work 12 rows.
These 234 rows form Stripe Pat.

Stripe Pat 4 (Right Panel)

With F, work 14 rows.
*With A, work 26 rows.
With F, work 26 rows.
Rep from * 3 times more.
With A, work 12 rows.
These 234 rows form Stripe Pat.

BLANKET

Main Panel 1

With B, cast on 22 sts.

Proceed in Stripe Pat 1 as follows:
**Knit 2 rows (garter st), noting first row is RS.

3rd row: (RS - inc). Kfb. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 24 sts.

4th row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 5 times more.
34 sts.

First 14 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 1, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS - dec). K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 32 sts.

2nd row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 5 times more.
22 sts.** Break B.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 1, rep from ** to ** 8 more times, until all 234 rows of Stripe Pat 1 are complete.
Cast off.

Main Panel 2

With D, cast on 22 sts.
Work as given for Main Panel 1 substituting Stripe Pat 2 for Stripe Pat 1.

Center Panel

With C, cast on 15 sts.

***Knit 2 rows (garter st), noting first row is RS.

3rd row: (RS - dec). K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 13 sts.

4th row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 4 times more. 5 sts.

Next row: K1. K3tog. K1. 3 sts.

Next row: Knit.

1st row: (RS - inc). K1. Kfbf. K1. 5 sts.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd row: Kfb. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 7 sts.

4th row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 4 times more.
15 sts.***

Rep from *** to *** 8 more times.
Cast off.

Left Panel

With A, cast on 14 sts.

Proceed in Stripe Pat 3 as follows:
****Knit 2 rows (garter st), noting first row is RS.

3rd row: (RS - dec). K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 13 sts.

4th row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 8 sts.
Break A.

First 14 rows of Stripe Pat 3 are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 3, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS - inc). With F, Kfb. Knit to end of row. 9 sts.

2nd row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 5 times more.
14 sts.****

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 3, rep from **** to ****, until all 234 rows of Stripe Pat 3 are complete.
Cast off.

Right Panel

With F, cast on 14 sts.

Proceed in Stripe Pat 4 as follows:
*****Knit 2 rows (garter st), noting first row is RS.

3rd row: (RS - dec). Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 13 sts.

4th row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 8 sts. Break F.

First 14 rows of Stripe Pat 4 are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 4, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). With A, knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 9 sts.

2nd row: Knit.

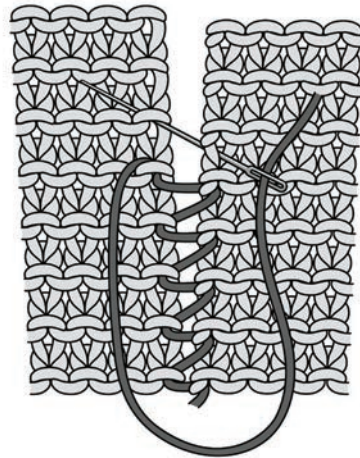
Rep last 2 rows 5 times more. 14 sts.*****

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat 4, rep from ***** to ***** , until all 234 rows of Stripe Pat 4 are complete.

Cast off.

FINISHING

With RS facing and cast on edges aligned, pin Panels tog. Sew Panels tog loosely to ensure Panels lay flat, using mattress st as shown in diagram. Use C for seaming along Center Panel and A or F for seaming along Left Panel and Right Panel.
