## What you will need:

**Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10:** 1 ball each 422 Golden Yellow **A**, 12 Black **B**, and 494 Victory Red **C**.

**Note:** Only small quantities of each color are needed for this project.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 2.75 mm [US C-2]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Approximately 7 sc = 1" [2.5 cm]. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Yummy Happy Face Emoji Appliqué

If you enjoy food, this is the perfect appliqué for you! This happy face can be attached to a jacket or other fabric item for a happy design note. Sew with needle and thread or use fabric glue for a quick attaching method.

Emoji measures 2¾" [7 cm] diameter.

**Note:** Use double strand of Thread throughout.

## EMOJI

Beginning at center, with **A**, ch 2.

**Round 1 (Right Side):** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st to first sc—6 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as joining and each sc around; join—12 sc.

**Round 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), dc in same sc as joining and each sc around; join with slip st in top of ch-3—24 sc.

**Round 4:** Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, \*dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of ch-3—36 dc.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, sc in same dc as joining and next 4 dc, 2 sc in next dc, \*sc in next 5 dc, 2 sc in next dc; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc—42 sc.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, sc in same sc as joining and next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first sc—48 sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Eye (make 2)

With **B**, ch 2; work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving end for sewing.

## Tongue

With **C**, ch 3; sc in 2nd ch from hook, 3 sc in next ch; working on opposite side of ch, work 1 sc. Fasten off, leaving end for sewing.

## Assembly

Referring to photo for placement, with one strand of **B**, embroider with back stitches to create smile. Sew Eyes and Tongue in place.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color **A**, Color **B**, Color **C** etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
