

## SUGAR BUSH WESTERN FRINGE CROCHET WRAP

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Beg** = Begin(ing)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Pat** = Pattern

**PM** = Place marker

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2tog** = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**Tr** = Treble crochet

**Tr2tog** = [(Yoh) twice. Draw up a loop in next st. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice  
Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

### SIZES

#### To fit bust measurement

**XS** 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

**S** 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

**M** 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

**L** 44-46" [112-117 cm]

**XL/2XL** 48-50" [122-127 cm]

### GAUGE

16 sts and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

### INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

### MATERIALS

**Sugar Bush® Shiver™** (1.75 oz/50 g; 120 yds/110 m)

**Sizes** XS M L L XL/2XL

**Main Color (MC)** Extremely Royal (1421) 5 5 6 7 7 balls

**Contrast A** Frosty Brown (1403) 5 5 6 7 7 balls

**Contrast B** Crisp Cream (1402) 3 4 4 5 5 balls

**Contrast C** Wintry White (1401) 4 4 5 5 6 balls

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Small button ¾" [2 cm]. Large Wooden button 1½" [3.5 cm].

### Notes:

- Wrap is worked from side-to-side. Sleeves are done separately then sewed into Wrap.
- Ch 4 counts as tr at beg of row.
- Every row changes color. Fasten off yarn at end of every row. Turn. Join next color with sl st to first st, then proceed.

### BODY

Stripe Pat (worked over odd number of sts).

**Note:** Ch 4 at beg of rows counts as tr.

**1st row:** (RS). With MC. 1 sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of chain. Turn.

**2nd row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**4th row:** With A, ch 4. 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**5th row:** With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each tr to end of row. Turn.

**6th row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**7th row:** With MC, ch 4. 1 tr in next sc to end of row. Turn.

**8th row:** With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each tr to end of row. Turn.

**9th row:** With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**10th row:** With B, ch 4. 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**11th row:** With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each tr to end of row. Turn.

**12th row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**13th row:** With C, ch 4. 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**14th row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each tr to end of row. Work 1 sc in turning ch. Turn.

**15th row:** With C, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

**16th to 18th rows:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

**19th row:** With C, as 16th row.

**20th row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc and ch-1 sp to end of row. Turn.

**21st row:** With C, ch 4. 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**22nd row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**23rd row:** With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**24th row:** With B, ch 4. 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**25th row:** With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each tr to end of row. Turn.

**26th row:** With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**27th row:** With MC, ch 4. 1 tr in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**28th to 40th rows:** With corresponding colors, rep 2nd to 14th rows.

**41st and 42nd rows:** With A, as 14th row.

**43rd to 49th rows:** With corresponding colors, rep 21st to 27th rows.

These 49 rows form Stripe Pat.

### Body

#### Right Front

Beg at right front edge, with MC, ch **129** (**131-133-135-137**).

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. **128** (**130-132-134-136**) sc.

Beg with 2nd row of pat, proceed in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx **12** (**13-15-16-17.5**)" [**30.5** (**33-35.5-38-44.5**) cm] ending on any WS row preceding an sc-row.

#### Right Armhole

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of the next 28 sts. Ch **30** (**32-34-36-38**). Skip next **30** (**32-34-36-38**) sts. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

### Back

Cont in Stripe Pat, until work from Right Armhole measures approx **13** (**14-15-16-17**)" [**33** (**35.5-38-40.5-43**) cm] ending on any RS row preceding an sc-row.

### Left Armhole

**1st row:** (WS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of the next 70 sts. Ch **30** (**32-34-36-38**). Skip next **30** (**32-34-36-38**) sts. 1 sc in st to end of row. Turn.

### Left Front

Cont in Stripe Pat, until work from left armhole measures approx **12** (**13-15-16-17.5**)" [**30.5** (**33-35.5-38-44.5**) cm] ending on RS. Fasten off.

### Sleeves

With MC, ch 15.

**Ribbing:** 1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 14 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 14 sts.

Rep last row **31** (**33-35-37-41**) times more. **Do not** fasten off.

Turn work sideways. Ch 1. Work **32** (**34-36-38-42**) sc evenly across long edge to end of row. Turn. Beg with 2nd row, work 5 rows in Stripe Pat.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

**Next row:** (RS - tr row). Ch 4. 1 tr in first st. 1 tr in each st to last st. 2 tr in last st. Turn.

**OR Next row:** (RS - sc row). Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last st. Turn. Pat 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows until there are **48 (52-56-58-62)** sts.

Cont even in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures **19 (19-19.5-19.5-20)" [48 (48-49.5-49.5-51) cm]**, ending on a WS row. PM at each end of last row.

**Shape cap: 1st row:** (RS - sc-row). Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. **46 (50-54-58-62)** sts.

**Or 1st row:** Ch 4. Tr2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Tr2tog. Turn.

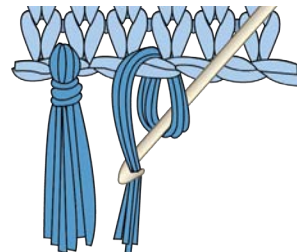
Keeping cont of pat, rep 1st row until there are **26 (28-30-32-34)** sts. **Next row:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Pat to last 4 sts. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn.

**Or Next row:** Ch 4. (Tr2tog) twice. Pat to last 4 sts. (Tr2tog) twice. Turn. Rep last row once more. **18 (20-22-24-26)** sts.

### FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Sew sleeve seams to markers. Sew in sleeves.

**Fringe:** Cut strands of yarn 10" [25.5 cm] long. Taking 4 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across right front edge. Trim fringe evenly.



### Buttons

Sew small button on WS above right front armhole. Sew large wooden button above left front shoulder. Use first and last row of treble stitches as buttonholes.
