A whimsical shape appliquéd with multi-color thread creates a leaf that only exists in fantasy to adorn this month's quilt block.

Required products: Coats Machine Embroidery thread

Materials

- 8 ½" x 10 ½" soft yellow background, Rowan Kaffe Fassett Shot Cotton, SC64 Sunshine
- 5" x 10" purple stripe for inside leaf, Rowan Kaffe Fassett Woven Strips WNARROW.REDXX
- 5" x 10" light green for outside leaf, Rowan Kaffe Fassett Shot Cotton, SCSC95 Honeydew
- 1 ½" x 1 ½" purple print, FreeSpirit True Colors by Jenean Morrison Buttons PWTC016.PURPL
- 2 ½" x 5" Lilac for stem, Rowan Kaffe Fassett Shot Cotton, SC36 Lilac
- Coats Machine embroidery thread, colors 315A Wild Iris, 855 Spring Greens
- 8 ½" x 10 ½" stabilizer for applique
- Qty 2 - 5" x 10 lightweight fusible webbing

Additional Requirements

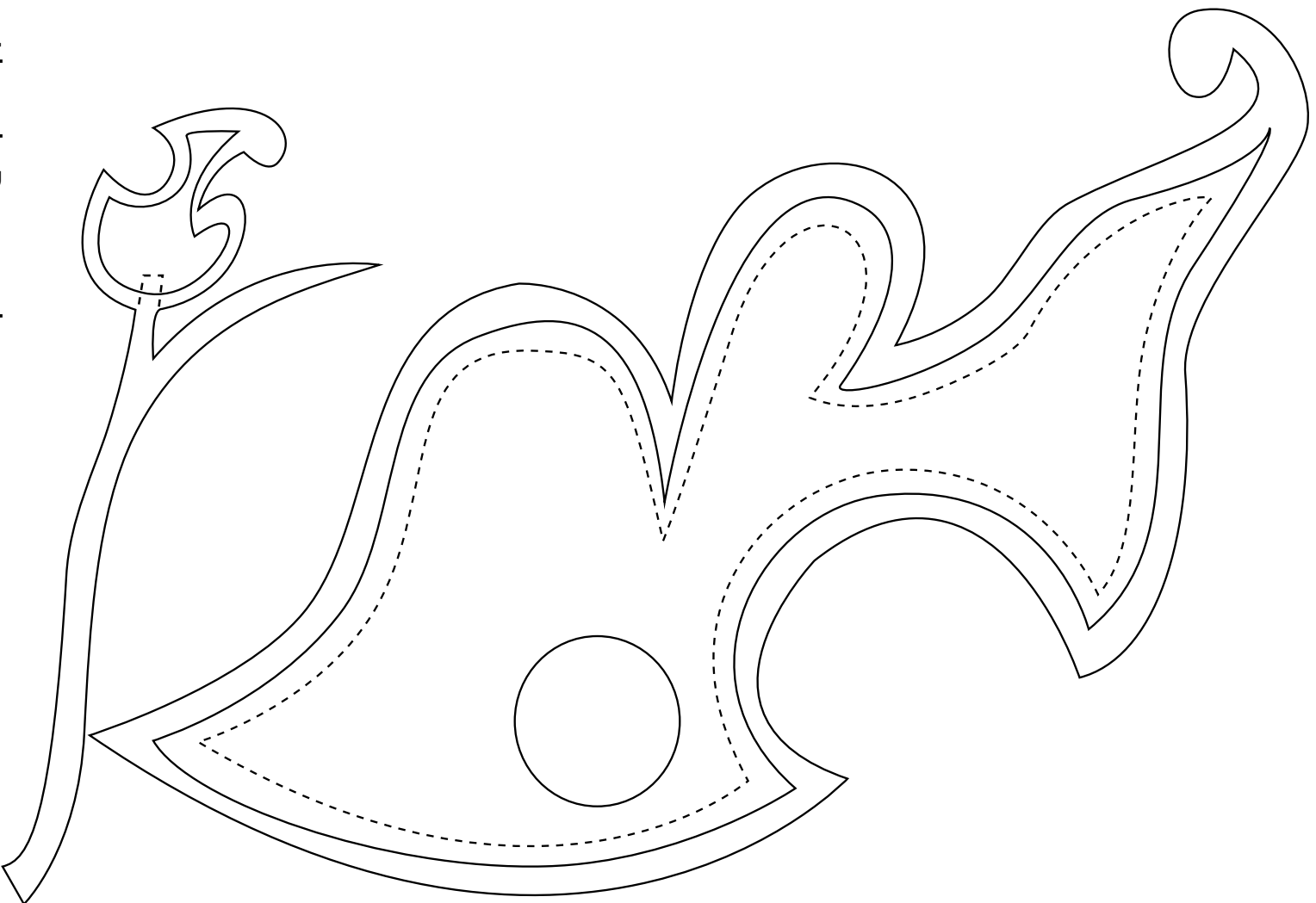
- Sewing Machine
- Iron & Ironing board.

Instructions

1. Trace the inside and outside parts of both leaves, the small circle, and the stem onto the paper side of the fusible webbing. The pattern has already been reversed.
Optional: To reduce bulk on the large leaf, make the green outside piece only to the dashed line on the pattern. Using the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the webbing to the wrong side of the fabric. Cut out all the pieces.
2. Peel the paper from the back of the leaves. Using the photo as a guide, place the pieces on the soft yellow background fabric. Using the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the leaves to the background.
3. Put the stabilizer on the back of the background fabric. Using machine embroidery thread color 855, edge stitch around the stem and choose a decorative stitch to stitch around the circle.
4. Using the same color thread, zig zag stitch around the light green leaves.
5. Change the machine embroidery thread 315A and zig zag stitch around the purple stripe leaves.
6. Using a removable marker, draw the leaf vein on the large leaf. With the same thread, zig zag the stem.
7. Remove the stabilizer.
