## What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 5 skeins  
(35 oz) 1546 Iris

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:  
8 mm [L-11 US]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 10 sts = 4" (10 cm); 8  
rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR  
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to  
obtain the gauge given.

# Lazy Waves Throw

*Here's the perfect throw for any room! Simply  
choose a color that you'll love to relax with  
and crochet away! The interesting coiled post  
stitches add a nice chevron texture.*

Throw measures 45" (114 cm) wide x 54"  
(137 cm) long.

## NOTES

1. Throw is worked back and forth in alternating rows of double crochet and single crochet.
2. Front post coil stitch is staggered across double crochet rows to create the appearance of waves.
3. When instructed to work into a stitch or space "2 rows below", work into the row numbered 2 less than the current row. For example, if you are working Row 5, a stitch "2 rows below" is in Row 5 - 2 = Row 3.

## Special Stitch

**Front Post Coil St (FPcs)** = Yarn over, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, [yarn over, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of same stitch] twice (7 loops on hook), [yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook] 6 times.

## THROW

Ch 109.

**Row 1 (right side):** Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc) and in each ch across, turn—107 dc.

**Row 2 and all even-numbered rows:** Ch 1, sc in each st, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 2, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last st, dc in last st, turn—14 FPcs; 93 dc.

**Row 7:** Ch 2, dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn—13 FPcs; 94 dc.

**Row 9:** Ch 2, dc in each of next 6 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 3 sts, dc in each of last 3 sts, turn.

**Row 11:** Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 4 sts, dc in each of last 4 sts, turn.

**Row 13:** Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 5 sts, dc in each of last 5 sts, turn.

**Row 15:** Ch 2, dc in each of next 3 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 6 sts, dc in each of last 6 sts, turn.

**Row 17:** Ch 2, dc in each of next 2 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 7 sts, dc in each of last 7 sts, turn.

**Row 19:** Ch 2, dc in first st, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, \*dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from \* across to last 8 sts, dc in each of last 8 sts, turn.

**Row 21:** Repeat Row 5.

**Row 23:** Repeat Row 19.

**Row 25:** Repeat Row 17.

**Row 27:** Repeat Row 15.

SHOP KIT

**Row 29:** Repeat Row 13.  
**Row 31:** Repeat Row 11.  
**Row 33:** Repeat Row 9.  
**Row 35:** Repeat Row 7.  
**Row 36:** Repeat Row 2.  
**Rows 37–100:** Repeat Rows 5–36 twice.  
**Row 101:** Repeat Row 5.  
**Row 102:** Repeat Row 2.  
**Row 103:** Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off.

### Border

**Round 1 (right side):** With right side facing and working in row-end sts across side, ch 1, sc in first row-end dc row, \*sc in next row-end sc, 2 sc in next row-end dc; repeat from \* across, ending with 1 sc in last row-end dc; working in opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in first ch (corner made), sc in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last corner ch (corner made); working in row-end sts across other side, 1 sc in first row-end dc, rep from \* to \* across other side, ending with 1 dc in last row-end dc, 3 sc in next corner st (corner made), sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last corner st (corner made); join with a slip st in first sc, turn—528 sc (105 sc between corners on each of top and bottom edges, 153 sc on each side between corners, 3 sc in each corner).

**Round 2 (wrong side):** Slip st in each of next 2 sc, ch 1, \*(sc, ch 2, sc) in center sc of first corner, ch 1, skip next sc, \*sc in next sc, ch 1, skip next sc\*; repeat from \* to \* across to next corner; repeat from \*\* around; join with slip st in first sc. Do not turn.

**Round 3:** \*(Slip st, ch 2, slip st) in next ch-2 space, ch 2, (slip st, ch 2) in each ch-1 space across to next corner; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in first slip st. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
