What you will need:

RED HEART® Stellar™: 2 balls of
9935 Nova.

OR

RED HEART® Stellar™ 8 oz: 1 ball
9935 Nova

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6.5 mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

GAUGE: 8 sts and 16 rows in sc =
4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size hook to obtain the
gauge.

City Sophisticate Hat

Crochet a hat that looks like it was made by a high-end milliner. This soft textured yarn is available in a range of unique fashion shades with just a hint of sparkle. Perfect for stepping up your cool weather style!

Directions are given for adult size Small. Changes for Large are in parentheses.

Hat measures 26 (30)" (71 [76] cm) in circumference.

HAT

Ch 4; join with a slip st in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, do not join — 8 sc. Work in a spiral, marking be of each round moving marker up as work progresses.

Round 2: 2 sc in each st around — 16 sc.

Round 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; repeat from * around — 24 sc.

Round 4: *Sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; repeat from * around — 32 sc

Round 5: *Sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; repeat from * around — 40 sc.

Round 6: *Sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; repeat from * around — 48 sts.

Round 7: *Sc in each of next 11 (5) sts, 2 sc in next st; repeat from * around — 52 (56) sc.

Size L Only

Round 8: *Sc in each of next 13 sts, 2 sc in next st; repeat from * around — 60 sc.

Both Sizes

Rounds 8-21 (9-21): Sc in each st around — 52 (60) sc.

Brim

Round 22: Ch 2 (counts as dc), dc in each st around; join with a slip st in top of beg ch-2 — 52 (60) dc.

Round 23: Repeat Row 22.

Round 24: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with a slip st in first sc — 52 (60) sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Roll up brim.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st.
