Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ One Pound ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $16 \mathrm{oz} / 453.6 \mathrm{~g} ; 812 \mathrm{yds} / 742 \mathrm{~m}$ )

Contrast A Succulent (10655)
Contrast B Lace (10585)
Contrast C Off White (10514)
Contrast D Hosta (10638)
Contrast E Rose (10517)
Contrast F Azure (10523)

1 ball or $419 \mathrm{yds} / 383 \mathrm{~m}$
1 ball or 326 yds/298 m
1 ball or $462 \mathrm{yds} / 422 \mathrm{~m}$
1 ball or $419 \mathrm{yds} / 383 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or $440 \mathrm{yds} / 402 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or $272 \mathrm{yds} / 249 \mathrm{~m}$

Size U.S. 8 [ 5 mm ] Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg $=\operatorname{Begin}($ ning $)$
Inc = Increase(ing)
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
K2(3)tog = Knit next 2(3) stitches together

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (approx) 49" x 52½" [124.5 x 133.5 cm ]

## GAUGE

16 stitches (sts) and 28 rows $=4 "$ [ 10 cm ] in garter st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Design is worked in multiple shades of garter stitch squares worked in 'Full, Half and Quarter' sizes. Follow diagram to join Squares to create final design.
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S t}(\mathbf{s})=$ Stitch $(\mathrm{es})$
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side

## FULL SQUARES

With A, make 7.
With B, make 22.
With C, make 20.
With D, make 17.
With E, make 18.
With F, make 7.
Cast on 3 stitches (sts).
1st row: [Wrong side (WS)]. Knit. 2nd row: Knit into front and back of next st (Kfb) to increase (inc) 1 st. Knit to end of row.
Repeat (rep) last row, increasing (inc) 1 st at beginning (beg) of every row to 28 sts, ending on a RS row.

## '̌arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Next row: Knit 1 (K1). Knit next 2 sts together (K2tog). Knit to end of row.
Rep last row until 3 sts remaining (rem).
Next row: Knit next 3 sts together (K3tog). Fasten off.

## HALF SQUARES

With A, make 6. With B, make 4. With D, make 4. With E, make 2. With F, make 11.

Cast on 3 sts.
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Kfb. Knit to end of row. Rep last row, inc 1 st at beg of every row until there are 28 sts, ending on a WS row.
Cast off.

QUARTER SQUARES (make 2)
With A, cast on 3 sts.
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Kfb. Knit to end of row. Rep last row, inc 1 st at beg of every row until there are 20 sts, ending on a WS row.
Cast off.

Seam Squares tog using mattress st as shown in assembly diagram.
