



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Beglnkdc = Insert hook down through horizontal bar in center of previous stitch, yoh and pull up a loop. Insert hook into ring, yoh and pull up a loop. Yoh and pull through first 2 loops on hook. Yoh and pull through last 2 loops on hook – Beginning Linked Dc made.

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Lnkdc = Insert hook down through the horizontal bar in the center of previous stitch, yoh and pull up a loop. Insert hook in indicated space or stitch and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through first 2 loops on hook. Yoh and pull through last 2 loops on hook – Linked Dc made.

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

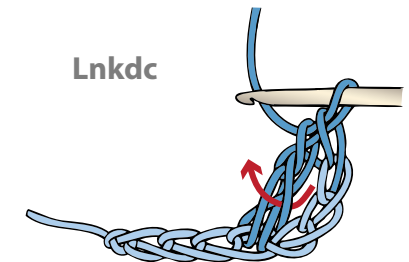
Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® Cone (14 oz/400 g; 674 yds/616 m)

Potpourri Prints (02178)

1 cone or 425 yds/388.5 m

Size U.S. E/4 (3.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® split-lock stitch count markers. Wooden ring approx 2" (5 cm) in diameter. 6 wooden beads approx ½" (1.5 cm) diameter. Susan Bates® steel yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 3½" x 8" [9 x 20.5 cm].

GAUGE

14 lnkdc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Rnds are worked as a spiral. First Inkdc of each rnd is worked into last Inkdc of previous rnd.

Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

Set-up rnd: (1 sc. 1 hdc. 1 dc. Place marker in dc. 8 begInkdc) in ring. 1 Inkdc in each st to marker. 10 sts.

1st rnd: (RS). Beg in first dc from previous rnd, work 2 Inkdc in each st around. 20 Inkdc.

2nd rnd: *1 Inkdc in next Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 30 Inkdc.

3rd rnd: *1 Inkdc in each of next 2 Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 40 Inkdc.

4th rnd: Working in back loops only, 1 Inkdc in each st around.

5th rnd: 1 Inkdc in each st around. Rep 5th rnd until work from 4th rnd measures 4½" [11.5 cm].

Next rnd: 1 Inkdc in each Inkdc to last 3 sts. 1 hdc in next Inkdc. 1 sc in each of next 2 Inkdc. Join with sl st to first st in rnd.

Shape Sides

Begin working in rows as follows:
****1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 8 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 10 sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st across. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each st to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn. 8 sts.

5th to 8th rows: Rep 3rd and 4th rows twice more. 4 sts.

9th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st across. Turn.

10th row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.

11th row: Ch 4. Join with sl st to next st. Fasten off.**

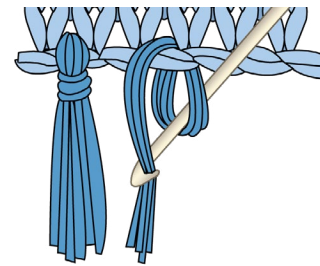
Join yarn with sl st to last rnd of Inkdc, leaving 8 sts between sl st and last st worked in first row of side shaping. Work from ** to ** as given above.

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st on upper edge of Plant Hanger. Work 1 rnd of sc evenly around edge, working 5 sc in each ch-4 sp. Join with sl st to first sc.

Next rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, work 1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Fringe

Cut strands of yarn 16" [40.5 cm] long. Taking 3 strands held tog, fold in half and knot into fringe along top of Plant Hanger as follows: use unworked front loops from last rnd of sc, work fringe into each of 6 sts on either side of ch-4 sps. Trim fringe evenly.



Hangers

Cut 12 lengths of yarn 18" [45.5 cm]. Holding 6 strands tog, thread through ch-4 sp at side of Plant Hanger, and fold in half so that ends meet. Thread all strands through a wooden bead; push bead to base of strands. Braid strands tog, with 4 strands held tog in each section of braid, until braid measures approx 5" [12.5 cm]. Thread all strands through another wooden bead to finish braid, ensuring bead is seated at top of braid. With 6 strands held on each side, wrap hanger strands around wooden ring. Thread all

strands through another bead, and secure with a knot. Trim evenly. Rep for opposite side of Plant Hanger.

Tassels (make 2).

Cut a piece of cardboard 5" [12.5 cm] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 60 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew 1 Tassel to base of Plant Hanger and sew 1 Tassel to center front of Plant Hanger as shown in photo.
