CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Fdc (Foundation double crochet) = Ch 3. Yoh. Insert hook in 3rd ch from hook and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through one loop on hook (ch made). (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook)

twice (1 dc made). *Yoh. Insert hook into ch stitch and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through one loop on hook (ch made). (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice (1 dc made). Rep from *.

Hdc = Half double crochet.

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

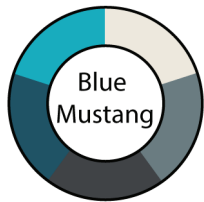
Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama™ O'Go™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 228 yds/208 m)

Blue Mustang (68016)

1 O'Go



Size U.S. M/N (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 33" [84 cm] around and 8" [20.5 cm] deep.

GAUGE

8 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- This cowl is made by working straight through the O'Go.

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Rnds are joined with a sl st to first st.

1st rnd (RS): FDC 66; join to work in the round. Use tail end to sew the bottom of the row closed. 66 dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 dcfp around first st. 1 hdc in next st. *1 dcfp around next st. 1 hdc in next st. Rep from * around. Join.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

4th rnd: As 3rd rnd.

5th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 dcfp around each of next 2 sts 2 rnds below. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

6th rnd: As 3rd rnd.

7th rnd: Ch 1. *1 dcfp around next dcfp 2 rnds below. Skip next dcfp 2 rnds below. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. 1 dcfp around skipped dcfp 2 rnds below. Rep from * around. Join.

8th rnd: As 3rd rnd.

9th rnd: Ch 1. *1 dcfp around next dcfp 2 rnds below. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. 1 dcfp around next dcfp 2 rnds below. Rep from * around. Join.

10th rnd: As 3rd rnd.

11th rnd: As 9th rnd.

12th rnd: As 3rd rnd.

13th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 sts. 1 dcfp around first dcfp of rnd 2 rnds below. 1 dcfp around next dcfp 2 rnds below. Skip next dcfp 2 rnds below. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. *1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 dcfp around skipped dcfp 2 rnds below. 1 dcfp around next dcfp 2 rnds below. Skip next dcfp 2 rnds below. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

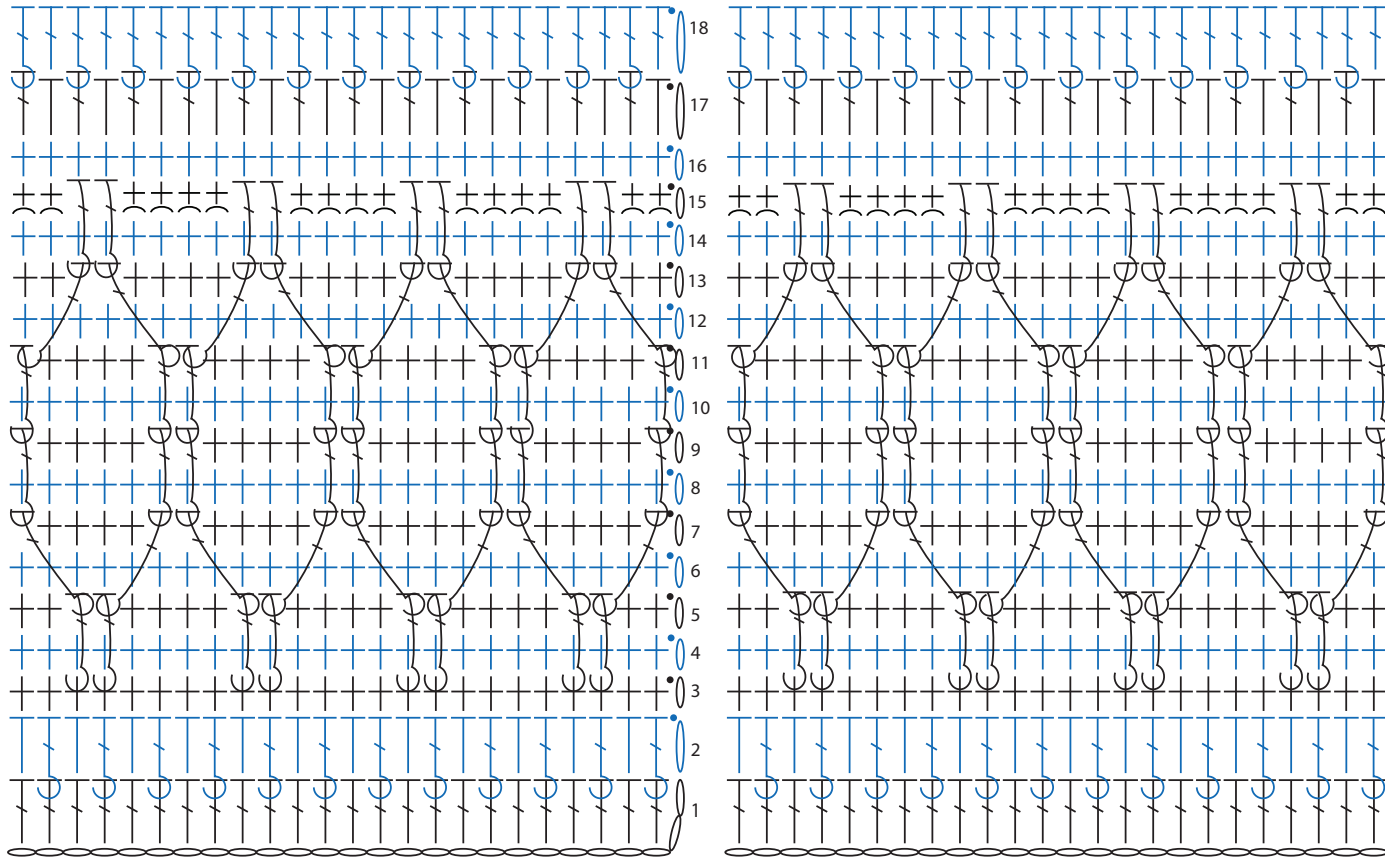
14th rnd: Rep 3rd rnd.

15th rnd: Ch 1. *1 scbl in each of next 2 sts. 1 dcfp around each of next 2 dcfp 2 rnds below. 1 scbl in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

16th rnd: Rep 3rd rnd.

17th rnd: Ch 1. 1 hdc in first st. 1 dc in next st. *1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in next st. Rep from * around. Join.

18th rnd: Ch 1. 1 dc in first st. 1 dcfp around next st. *1 dc in next st. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from * around. Join. Fasten off.



Reduced sample of pattern

- STITCH KEY**
- = chain (ch)
 - ⊥ = single crochet (sc)
 - ⊥ = single crochet in the back loop (scbl)
 - ⊥ = half double crochet (hdc)
 - ⊥ = double crochet (dc)
 - ⊥ = front post dc (dcfp)
