



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Beg = Begin(ning)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together.

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

M1L = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch from front to back and knitting into back of loop.

M1R = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch from back to front and knitting into front of loop

P = Purl

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

Right Mitten

**With smaller set of needles and MC, cast on 36 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles. PM. Join to beg work in rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep 1st rnd for 2½" [6.5 cm].

Change to larger set of needles.
Next rnd: (K8. Kfb) 4 times. 40 sts. Knit even in rnds for 1" [2.5 cm].**

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K21. M1R. K2. M1L. Knit to end of rnd. 42 sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: K21. M1R. K4. M1L. Knit to end of rnd. 44 sts.

5th rnd: K21. M1R. K6. M1L. Knit to end of rnd. 46 sts.

7th rnd: K21. M1R. K8. M1L. Knit to end of rnd. 48 sts.

9th rnd: K21. M1R. K10. M1L. Knit to end of rnd. 50 sts.

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Soft® (5 oz/141 g; 256 yds/234 m)

Main Color (MC) White (4600) **1 ball**

Contrast A Really Red (9925) **1 ball**

Sets of 4 sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or sizes needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Scrap yarn or stitch holder.
