

CARON® BURNING UP BRIOCHE KNIT COWL



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EXPERIENCED**



MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Contrast A Dark Pink (10621) **1 ball**

Contrast B Country Rose (10535) **1 ball**

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needles 16" (40.5 cm) long **or size needed to obtain gauge**. Stitch marker. Cable needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

BrDecl= (See photos on page 5) [Worked over 3 stitches]. Slip next stitch knit-wise with yarn at back of work (Sl1yo). BrK2tog through all strands. Pass both strands of slipped stitch over. 2 stitches decreased.

BrDecR = (See photos on page 6.) [Worked over 3 stitches]. Slip next stitch knit-wise with yarn at back of work (Sl1yo). Knit next stitch. Pass slipped stitch over stitch just knit and move stitch to left-hand needle. Pass second stitch on left-hand needle over first stitch. Move stitch to right-hand needle. 2 stitches decreased.

BrDbIDec = (See photos on page 7 & 8.) [Worked over 5 stitches] Slip next 2 stitches knit-wise one at a time with yarn at back of work. Slip next stitch to cable needle and leave at front of work. Knit next stitch. Pass 2 slipped stitches over just-knit stitch and move stitch to left-hand needle. Pass second stitch on left-hand needle over first and move stitch to right-hand needle. Slip

stitch from cable needle to left-hand needle. Slip last-worked stitch from right-hand needle to left-hand needle. Pass second stitch on left-hand needle over first. Move stitch to right-hand needle. 4 stitches decreased.

BrK1 = (See photos on page 4.) Knit next stitch together with accompanying yarn over

BrP1 = (See photos on page 4.) Purl next stitch together with accompanying yarn over

Cont = Continue

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sl1yo = (See photos on page 4.) Slip next stitch purl-wise with yarn in front of work, bringing yarn over needle (and over slipped st) to back of work. Yarn is in place to work a knit stitch. If Sl1yo precedes a purl stitch, bring yarn under needle to front of work to maintain yo before working purl stitch.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 24" [61 cm] in circumference x 14" [35.5 cm] deep.

GAUGE

12 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: The wrap (yarn over) created by Sl1yo **does not** count as a separate st and should be treated as 1 st along with slipped st it accompanies.

With larger needles and B, cast on 84 sts. Join for working in rnd, placing marker on first st.

Switch to smaller needles.

1st rnd (set up rnd): With A, *K1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: With A, *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

4th rnd: With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.

Rep last 2 rnds 6 times more.

Proceed in Pat as follows:

See Chart shown right.

1st rnd: With A, *BrDecL. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. BrDecR. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: With B, *(Sl1yo. BrP1) 3 times. (Sl1yo. P1) twice. Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: With A, *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

4th rnd: With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.

5th and 6th rnds: As 3rd and 4th rnds.

7th rnd: With A, *BrDbldDec. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

8th rnd: With B, *(Sl1yo. BrP1) twice. (Sl1yo. P1) twice. (Sl1yo. BrP1) twice. Rep from * around.

9th to 12th rnds: As 3rd to 6th rnds.

13th rnd: With A, *(BrK1. yo. BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo. BrDecL. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. BrDecR. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

14th rnd: With B, *(Sl1yo. P1) twice. (Sl1yo. BrP1) 4 times. Rep from * around.

15th to 18th rnds: As 3rd to 6th rnds.

19th rnd: With A, *BrK1. Sl1yo. (BrK1. yo. BrK1. yo. BrK1) all in next st. Sl1yo. BrK1. Sl1yo. BrDbldDec. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.

20th rnd: With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. (Sl1yo. P1) twice. (Sl1yo. BrP1) 3 times. Rep from * around.

21st to 24th rnds: As 3rd to 6th rnds.

These 24 rnds form Pat.

Cont in Pat until work from beg measures approx 12" [30.5 cm], ending on a 2nd, 10th, 14th or 20th rnd.

Next rnd: With A, *BrK1. Sl1yo. Rep from * around.








Next rnd: With B, *Sl1yo. BrP1. Rep from * around.

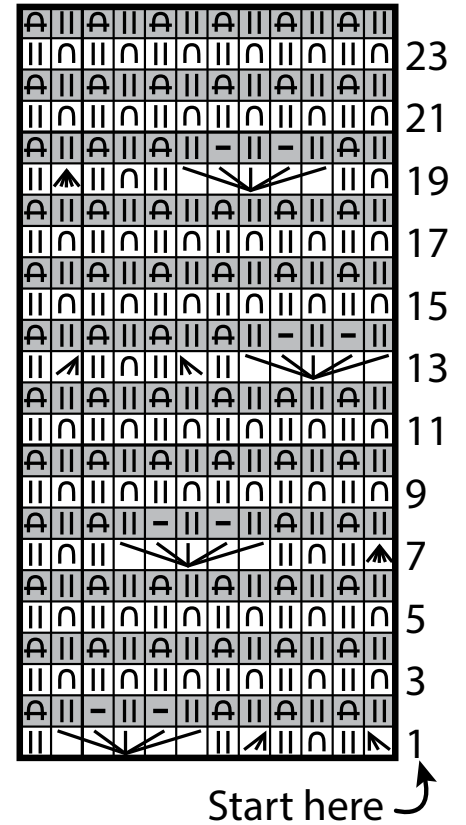
Rep last 2 rnds 6 times more.

With larger needle and B, cast off as follows:

*BrK1. P1. Pass first st over 2nd st. *BrK1. Pass first st over 2nd st. P1. Pass first st over 2nd st. Rep from * around. Fasten off last st.

-  = BrP1
-  = Purl



ABBREVIATIONS DIAGRAMS

Sl1yo = Slip next stitch purl-wise with yarn in front of work, bringing yarn over needle (and over slipped stitch) to back of work. Yarn is in place to work a BrK1 stitch. If Sl1yo precedes a BrP1 stitch, bring yarn under needle to front of work to maintain yo before working BrP1 stitch.



BrK1 = Knit next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.



BrP1 = Purl next stitch together with accompanying yarn over.



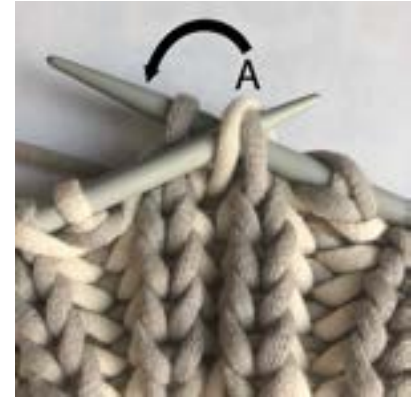
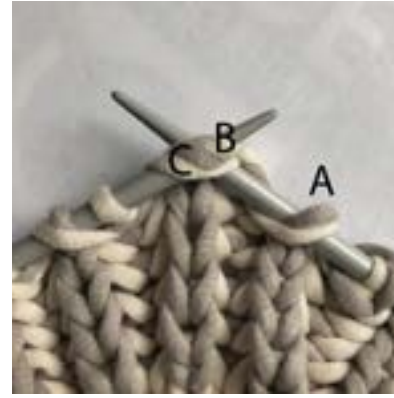
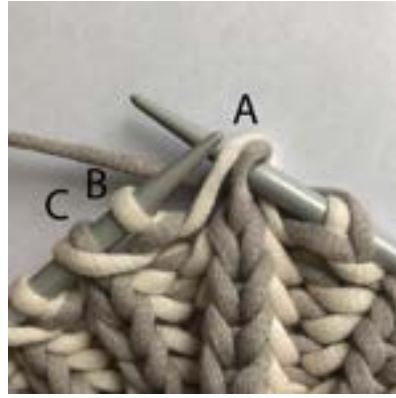
BRIOCHE LEFT DECREASE

BrDecl = Worked over 3 stitches (A, B, C).

1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (Sl1yo).

2) BrK2tog (B, C) through all strands.

3) Pass both strands of slipped stitch (A) over.



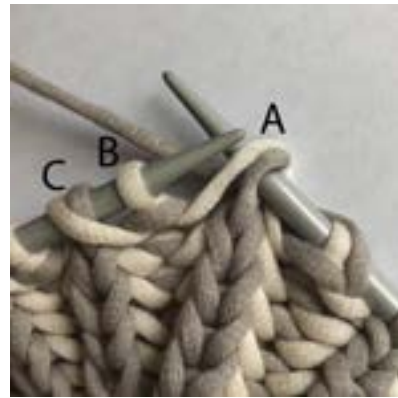
4) 2 stitches decreased.



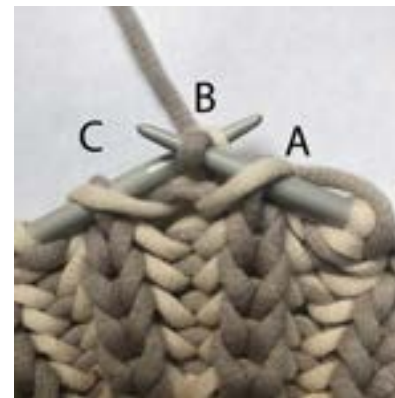
BRIOCHE RIGHT DECREASE

BrDecR = Worked over 3 stitches (A, B, C).

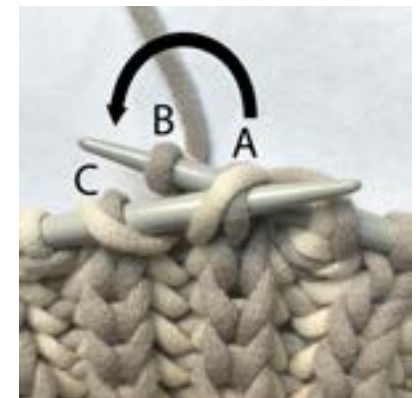
1) Slip next stitch (A) knit-wise with yarn at back of work (Sl1yo).



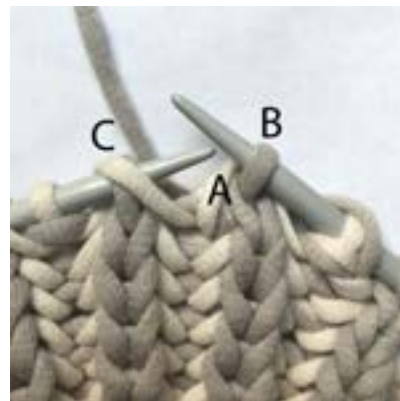
3) Knit next stitch (B).



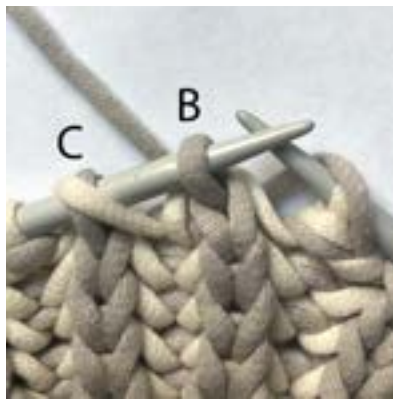
4a) Pass slipped stitch (A) over stitch just knit (B)...



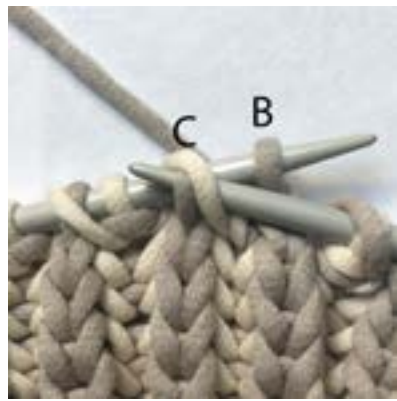
4b) ...

6) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (C) over first stitch (B).



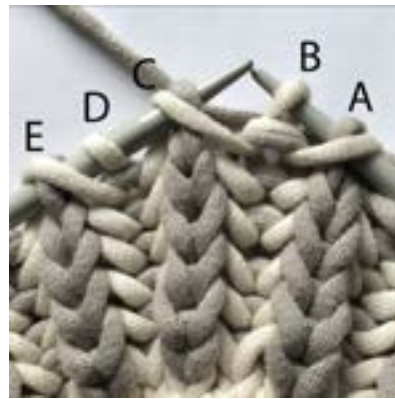
7) Move stitch to right-hand needle. 2 stitches decreased.



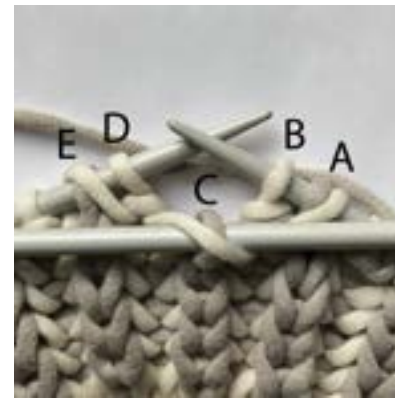
BRIOCHE DOUBLE DECREASE

BrDbIDec = [Worked over 5 stitches (A, B, C, D, E)].

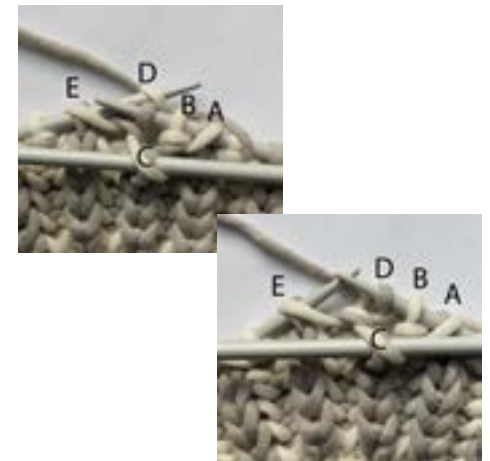
1) Slip next 2 stitches (A and B) knit-wise one at a time with yarn at back of work.



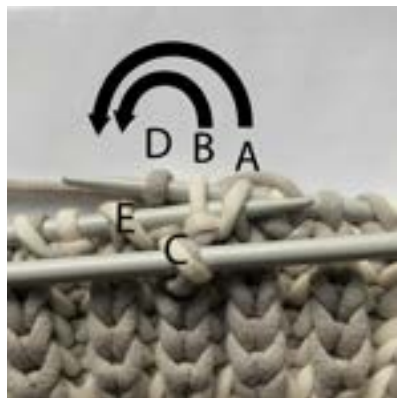
2) Slip next stitch (C) to cable needle and leave at front of work.



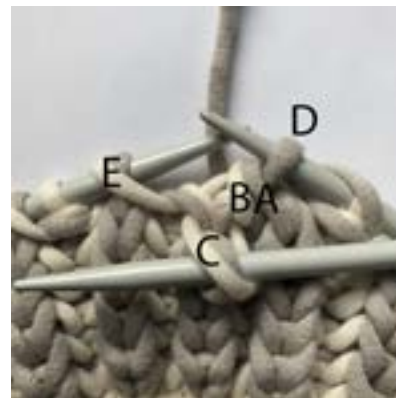
3) Knit next stitch (D).



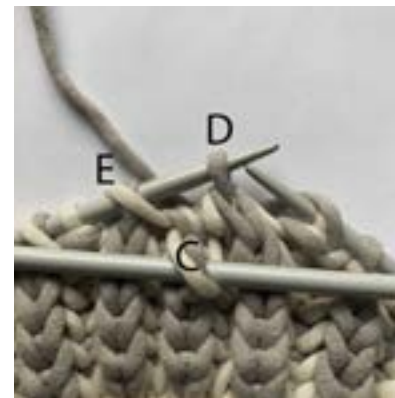
4a) Pass 2 slipped stitches (A and B) over just-knit stitch (D)...



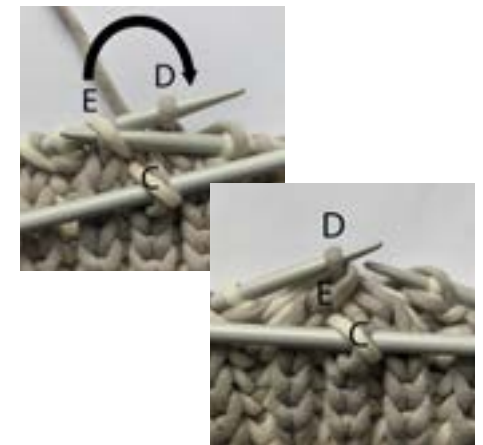

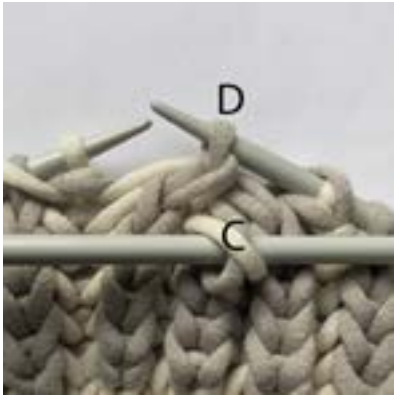
5) ... and move stitch to left-hand needle.



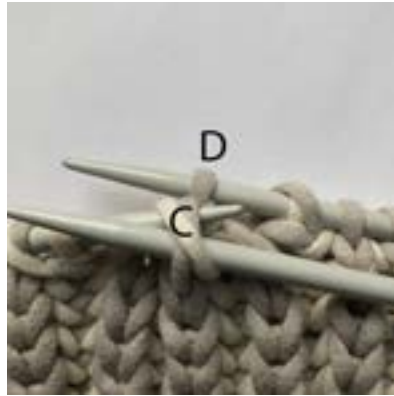
6a) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (E) over first stitch (D)...



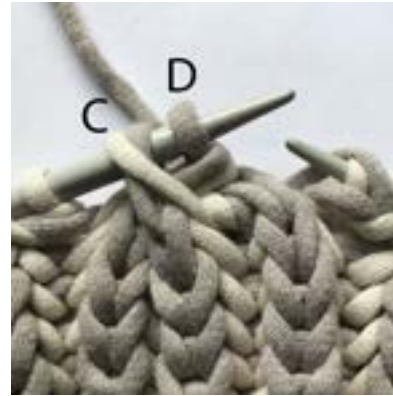
7) ... and move stitch to right-hand needle.



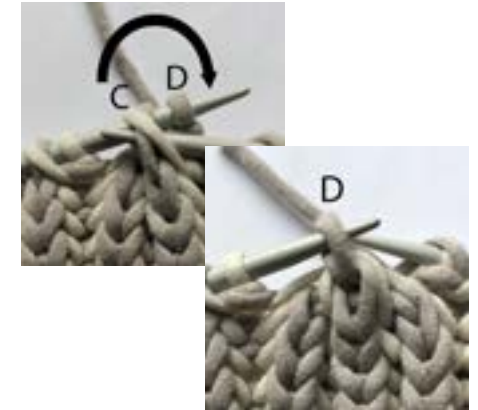
8) Slip stitch from cable needle (C) to left-hand needle.



9) Slip last-worked stitch (D) from right-hand needle to left-hand needle.



10) Pass second stitch on left-hand needle (C) over first stitch (D).



Move stitch to right-hand needle. 4 stitches decreased.
