



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Hygge Fur™ (7 oz/200 g; 260 yds/238 m)
Slate Blue (0807) **2 balls**

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Fiberfil Stuffing. 2 stitch markers.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont = Continue(ity)
Inc = Increase(ing)
PM = Place marker
Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENT

Approx 14" [35.5 cm] diameter.

GAUGE

11 sc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Place marker on first st of rnd for easier counting.
- Cushion is stuffed with larger diameter pillow form to create a sturdier cushion.
- Pattern calls for 4 ties to secure cushion to top of stool. If your stool has a different leg configuration than shown in photo you may need to adjust the number and spacing of ties.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

Top and Bottom (make 2)

Ch 2.

1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 30 sc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 36 sc.

Cont in this manner inc 6 sts evenly each rnd until diameter of work measures 14" [35.5 cm] across widest measurement. PM at end of rnd.

Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Rep last rnd until work from marker measures 1" [2.5 cm].


Fasten off.

Ties (make 4)

Ch 40.

Fasten off.

Adding Ties: With RS of Bottom facing, taking one Tie, fold in half and knot through any sc along marked rnd. Rep for rem 3 ties, ensuring ties are spaced evenly around cushion along marked rnd.



Seaming: With WS of Top and Bottom facing each other and final rnds aligned, join yarn with sl st through both thicknesses to any sc. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, sc in each sc around, stuffing cushion as you work. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
