Finished bust

Extra-Small/Small - 37" [94 cm]

2/3 XL - 56" [142 cm]

4/5 XL - 63" [160 cm]

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool DK Superwash™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 125 yds/114 m)

SIZES

Main Color (MC) Apple Green (12223)	9	9	10	11	12	13	balls
Contrast A Cork (12012)	1	1	2	2	2	2	balls

Contrast C Gold (12609)	1	1	1	1	2	2	balls
Contrast D Pumpkin (12630)	1	1	2	2	2	2	balls

Sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and (4 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** 3 st holders. 5 buttons.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Stripe Pat

With A work 2 rows stocking st.

With B work 4 rows stocking st.

With A work 2 rows stocking st.

With MC work 14 rows stocking st.

With C work 2 rows stocking st.

With D work 4 rows stocking st.

With C work 2 rows stocking st.

With MC work 14 rows stocking st.

These 44 rows form Stripe Pat.

BACK

With D and smaller needles, cast on **102 (114-122-134-154-174)** sts. Break D. Join MC.

1st row: (RS). With MC, *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2½" [6 cm], ending with a 2nd row and inc **0 (0-2-0-0-0)** sts evenly across last row. **102 (114-124-134-154-174)** sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Proceed in Stripe Pat for 8 rows.

Cont in Stripe Pat and work side dec as follows:

1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to last

5 sts. ssk. K3.

Work 9 rows even in pat.

Rep last 10 rows 3 times more.

94 (106-116-126) sts.

Work 10 rows even in pat.

Cont in Stripe Pat and work side inc as follows:

1st row: (RS). K3. Inc1 in next st. Knit to last 4 sts. Inc1 in next st. K3.

Work 9 rows even in pat.

Rep last 10 rows 3 times more.

102 (114-124-134) sts.

All sizes: Cont even in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx 17½" [44.5 cm], ending with any purl row of MC. Break A, B, C and D.

Shape armholes: With MC only, cast off **4 (5-6-8-10-14)** sts beg next 2 rows. **94 (104-112-118-134-146)** sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

2nd row: P2. P2togtbl. Purl to last 4 sts. P2tog. P2.

Rep last 2 rows **1 (2-2-2-3-5)** time(s) more. **86 (92-100-106-118-122)** sts.

Next row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **5 (6-8-8-12-11)** times more. **74 (78-82-88-92-98)** sts.

Cont even until armhole measures **8 (8½-9-9½-10-10½)" [20.5 (21.5-23-24-25.5-26.5)** cm, ending with a purl row.



Shape shoulders and back neck:

1st row: (RS). Cast off **6 (7-7-8-8-9)** sts. **K13 (14-15-16-17-18)**, including st on needle after cast off. **K2tog. Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder.

2nd row: P2tog. Purl to end of row.

3rd row: Cast off **6 (7-7-8-8-9)** sts. Knit to last 2 sts. **K2tog.**

4th row: Purl.

Cast off rem **7 (7-8-8-9-9)** sts.

With RS facing, cast off **32 (32-34-36-38-40)** sts onto a st holder. Join MC to rem sts and proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). ssk. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: Cast off **6 (7-7-8-8-9)** sts. Purl to last 2 sts. **P2togtbl.**

3rd row: ssk. Knit to end of row.

4th row: Cast off **6 (7-7-8-8-9)** sts. Purl to end of row.

5th row: Knit.

Cast off rem **7 (7-8-8-9-9)** sts.

LEFT FRONT

With D and smaller needles, cast on **50 (54-58-66-74-86) sts. Break D. Join MC.

1st row: (RS). With MC, *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. **K2.**

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. **P2.**

Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2½" [6 cm], ending with a 2nd row and inc **1 (3-3-1-3-1)** st(s) evenly across last row. **51 (57-61-67-77-87)** sts.**

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Proceed in Stripe Pat for 8 rows.

Cont in Stripe Pat and work side dec as follows:

1st row: (RS). K3. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Work 9 rows even in pat.

Rep last 10 rows 3 times more. **47 (53-57-63)** sts.

Work 10 rows even in pat.

Cont in Stripe Pat and work side inc as follows:

1st row: (RS). K3. Inc1 in next st. Knit to end of row.

Work 9 rows even in pat.

Rep last 10 rows 3 times more. **51 (57-61-67)** sts.

All sizes: Cont even in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures same length as Back, ending with purl row and same row of pat. Break A, B, C and D.

Shape armhole: With MC only, cast off **4 (5-6-8-10-14)** sts beg next row. **47 (52-55-59-67-73)** sts.

1st row: (WS). Purl to last 4 sts. **P2tog. P2.**

2nd row: K2. K2tog. Knit to end of row. Rep last 2 rows **1 (2-2-2-3-5)** time(s) more. **43 (46-49-53-59-61)** sts.

Purl 1 row.

Shape V-neck and armhole: Next row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1. Place marker at end of row.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **5 (6-8-8-12-11)** times more. **31 (32-31-35-33-37)** sts.

Next row: (RS). Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **6 (4-0-3-0-3)** times more. **24 (27-30-31-32-33)** sts.

Next row: (RS). Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows **5 (6-8-7-7-6)** times more. **18 (20-21-23-24-26)** sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back, ending with a purl row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off **6 (7-7-8-8-9)** sts beg of next and following alt row. Purl 1 row. Cast off rem **6 (6-7-7-8-8)** sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Left Front.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only: Proceed in Stripe Pat for 8 rows. Cont in Stripe Pat and work side dec as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 5 sts. ssk. K3. Work 9 rows even in pat.

Rep last 10 rows 3 times more. **47 (53-57-63)** sts.

Work 10 rows even in pat.

Cont in Stripe Pat and work side inc as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. Inc1 in next st. K3.

Work 9 rows even in pat.

Rep last 10 rows 3 times more. **51 (57-61-67)** sts.

All sizes: Cont even until work from beg measures same length as Back, ending with knit row and 1 extra row of MC. Break A, B, C and D.

Shape armhole: With MC only, cast off **4 (5-6-8-10-14)** sts beg next row. **47 (52-55-59-67-73)** sts.

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2. **2nd row:** P2. P2togtbl. Purl to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows **1 (2-2-2-3-5)** time(s) more. **43 (46-49-53-59-61)** sts.

Shape V-neck and armhole: Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2. Place marker at beg of row.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **5 (6-8-8-12-11)** times more. **31 (32-31-35-33-37)** sts.

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **6 (4-0-3-0-3)** times more. **24 (27-30-31-32-33)** sts.

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows **5 (6-8-7-7-6)** times more. **18 (20-21-23-24-26)** sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back, ending with a knit row.



Shape shoulder: Cast off **6 (7-7-8-8-9)** sts beg of next and following alt row. Knit 1 row. Cast off rem **6 (6-7-7-8-8)** sts.

SLEEVES

With D and smaller needles, cast on **50 (50-54-54-58-62)** sts. Break D. Join MC.

1st row: (RS). With MC, *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 2½" [6 cm], ending with a 2nd row.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Stripe Pat inc 1 st each end of needle on next and every following **6th (4th-4th-4th-4th-4th)** row until there are **78 (66-74-94-94-108)** sts, then every following **8th (6th-6th-6th-6th-6th)** row until there are **82 (88-94-100-104-110)** sts.

Cont even in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx **17½ (17½-17½-17-17-16½)" [44.5 (44.5-44.5-43-43-42)** cm], ending with any purl row of MC. Break A, B, C and D.

With MC only, proceed as follows.

Shape top: Cast off **3 (4-5-6-7-10)** sts beg next 2 rows. **76 (80-84-88-90-90)** sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **10 (10-11-12-13-15)** times more. **54 (58-60-62-62-58)** sts.

1st row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Knit to last 4 sts. ssk. K2.

2nd row: P2. P2togtbl. Purl to last 4 sts. P2tog. P2.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows until there are **18 (18-20-22-22-22)** sts. Cast off.

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements and cover with damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Button band and collar: With D and smaller needles cast on 8 sts. Break D. Join MC.

1st row: (RS). With MC, K1. (P1. K1) 3 times. K1.

2nd row: (K1. P1) 4 times.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures along front edge length to fit from cast on edge to marked row (beg of V-neck shaping), ending with WS row. Sew in place as you knit, stretching band slightly to fit along front edge.

Shape collar: 1st row: (RS). Inc1 in first st. Rib to last 2 sts. Inc1 in next st. K1.

2nd row: Sl1P. Rib to end of row, taking inc sts into (K1. P1) ribbing.

3rd row: Rib to last st. K1.

4th row: As 2nd row.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 28 sts.

Cont even in ribbing, slipping first st on WS until collar measures length to fit along V-neck edge and ends at center of back neck edge, ending with a WS row. Cast off in rib.

Place markers for 5 buttons on button band, having bottom button 4 rows

up from cast off edge, top button at last row of button band and rem 3 sts spaced evenly between.

Work buttonholes to correspond to button markers as follows:

1st row: (RS). K2. P1. Cast off 2 sts. K1. P1. K1.

2nd row: P1. K1. P1. Cast on 2 sts over cast off sts. K1. P1. K1.

Buttonhole band and collar: With D and smaller needles cast on 8 sts. Break D. Join MC.

1st row: (RS). With MC, K2. (P1. K1) 3 times.

2nd row: (P1. K1) 4 times.

Rep last 2 rows, noting buttonhole position, until work from beg measures along front edge length to fit from cast on edge to marked row (beg of V-neck shaping), ending with WS row. Sew in place as you knit.

Shape collar: 1st row: (RS). Sl1. Inc1 in next st. Rib to last 2 sts. Inc1 in next st. K1. 9 sts.

2nd row: Rib to last st, taking inc sts into (K1. P1) ribbing. P1.

3rd row: Sl1. Rib to end of row.






4th row: As 2nd row.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 28 sts.

Cont even in ribbing, slipping first st on RS until collar measures length to fit along V-neck edge and ends at center of back neck edge, ending with a WS row. Cast off in rib.

Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

WS = Wrong side
