## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Soft®:** 10 balls  
9273 Very Pink

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
6mm [US J-10].

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical  
for this project.

in solid color 5  
oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m);  
multicolor 4 oz (113 g), 204

# Loving Hearts Crochet Shawl

Send this comforting shawl to let someone know you care. The textured crochet hearts are a loving reminder of your love.

SHOP KIT

**Shawl measures 24½" wide x 70" long  
(62 x 178 cm).**

## Notes

1. Shawl is made in 3 sections: Cable Panel and 2 Heart Panels. First Heart Panel continues from Cable Panel; 2nd Heart Panel is made separately and sewn to Cable Panel.
2. When instructed to work around a stitch "2 rows below", work into the row numbered 2 less than the current row. For example, if you are working Row 4, a stitch "2 rows below" is Row 4 - 2 = Row 2.

## Special Stitches

**base cable** = Skip next 2 stitches 2 rows below, Fptr around next 2 stitches 2 rows below, ch 1, working in front of stitches just made, Fptr around first skipped stitch, Fptr around 2nd skipped stitch.

**bobble** = [Yarn over, insert hook in indicated space and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 5 times (6 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all 6 loops on hook.

**center cable** = Fptr around first 2 stitches of next base cable 2 rows below, slip st in bobble, Fptr around last 2 stitches of same base cable.

**Fptr (Front post treble crochet)** = [Yarn over] twice, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of the indicated stitch; yarn over and pull across a loop (4 loops on hook), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] 3 times.

**top cable** = Fptr around each Fptr of next center cable 2 rows below.

## Special Technique

**Join with sc** = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

## SHAWL Cable Panel

Ch 29.

**Row 1 (wrong side):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—28 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st across, turn—28 dc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, working last sc in top of beginning ch, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, Fptr around next 2 sts 2 rows below, [dc in next st, work base cable, dc in next st, Fptr around next 2 sts 2 rows below] across to last st, dc in last st, turn—3 base cables, 8 tr, and 8 dc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, [sc in each st across to ch-1 space of next base cable, bobble in ch-1 space] 3 times, sc in each remaining st across, working last sc in top beginning ch, turn—28 sc and 3 bobbles.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, Fptr around next 2 sts 2 rows below, [dc in next st, work center cable, dc in next st, Fptr around next 2 sts 2 rows below] across to last st, dc in last st, turn—3 center cables, 8 tr, and 8 dc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, skipping slip sts, sc in each dc and tr across, working last sc in top beginning ch, turn—28 sc.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, Fptr around next 2 sts 2 rows below, [dc in next st, work top cable, dc in next st, Fptr around next 2 sts] across to last st, dc in last st, turn—20 tr and 8 dc.

**Rows 9–200:** Repeat Rows 3–8 thirty-two times.

**Rows 201 and 202:** Repeat Rows 3 and 4.

**Row 203:** Ch 1, skipping all ch-1 spaces, sc in each dc and tr across. Do not turn or fasten off.

### First Side Edging

**Row 1:** Ch 1, working in ends of rows of first long side, 2 sc in Row 203, 2 sc in each even-numbered dc row to Row 2, 3 sc in Row 2, 2 sc in Row 1, turn—207 sc.

### First Heart Panel

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first 11 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 22 sts, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—198 sc and 9 bobbles.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in each sc and bobble across, turn—207 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 3 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 18 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 3 sts, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—191 sc and 16 bobbles.

**Row 5:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in first 7 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 7 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 14 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 7 sts, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—189 sc and 18 bobbles.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 11 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 10 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 11 sts, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 15 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 6 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 15 sts, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—189 sc and 18 bobbles.

**Row 11:** Repeat Row 3.

**Rows 12–15:** Repeat Rows 10 and 11 twice.

**Row 16:** Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 7 sts, bobble in next st] twice, {sc in next 6 sts, [bobble in next st, sc in next 7 sts] twice, bobble in next st} 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—180 sc and 27 bobbles.

**Row 17:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 18:** Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 4 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 3 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 4 sts, bobble in next st, [sc in next 8 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 4 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 3 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next 4 sts, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—171 sc and 36 bobbles.

**Row 19:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 20:** Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next st, bobble in next st, sc in next 7 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next st, bobble in next st, [sc in next 10 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next st, bobble in next st, sc in next 7 sts, bobble in next st, sc in next st, bobble in next st] 8 times, sc in each remaining st across, turn—171 sc and 36 bobbles.

**Row 21:** Repeat Row 3. Fasten off.

### 2nd Side Edging

**Row 1:** With wrong side of Cable Panel facing and working in ends of rows, join yarn with sc in first row, sc in same row, 2 sc in each even-numbered dc row to Row 202, 3 sc in Row 202, 2 sc in last row—207 sc. Fasten off.

### 2nd Heart Panel

Ch 208.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—207 sc.

**Rows 2–21:** Repeat Rows 2–21 of First Heart Panel.

Referring to photo as guide for positioning, sew last row of 2nd Heart Panel to 2nd Side Edging.

**Border Round:** With right side facing, join yarn with sc in first st of last row of First Heart Panel, 2 sc in same st, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st; working in ends of rows and in opposite side of foundation ch of first short edge, sc evenly spaced across; working in opposite side of foundation ch of 2nd Heart Panel, 3 sc in first ch, sc in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in ends of rows and in sts of 2nd short edge, sc evenly spaced across; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **{ }** = work directions in braces the number of times specified; **\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
