# **Patons** Pooling Crochet Infinity SCARF Designed by Emily Berney | CROCHET



#### **MATERIALS**

Patons<sup>®</sup> Classic Wool DK Superwash<sup>™</sup> (1.75 oz/50 q; 125 yds/114 m) Main Color (MC) Autumn Spice (12436) 6 balls

Contrast A Claret (12532)

1 ball

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately **Beg** = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**Sc** = Single crochet **SI st** = Slip stitch

**St** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together



CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 10" [25.5 cm] wide x 52" [132 cm] around.

#### GAUGE

22 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Notes: Obtaining exact stitch and row gauge is critical for successful planned pooling to achieve the pattern shown in photo.

When joining new ball, join at exact point in color sequence as previous ball.

With MC, ch 58.

1st row: 1 sc in 4th ch from hook. \*Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from \* to end of chain. Turn, 56 sts.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 sc in first ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last ch. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last ch-2 sp. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 52" [132 cm]. Fasten off. Sew ends of Scarf tog.

**Edging:** With RS facing, join A with sl st to top edge at seam. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Rep for bottom edge.
