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CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hdss = Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch, then pull directly through two loops on hook.

Hhdc = Herringbone half double crochet: Yoh. Draw up a loop through next stitch and first loop on hook. Yoh and draw through last 2 loops on hook.

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® The Original™ (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A White (00001)

Contrast B Tangerine (01699) **or** **1 ball**

Rose Pink (00046) **or**

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® Super Size™ (4 oz/113 g; 190 yds/174 m)

Mod Blue (18111) **1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8 x 9" [20.5 x 23 cm].

GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- When joining colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed.
- Carry color not in use loosely up side of work.



Hot Pad (make 2)

With B, ch 24.

1st row: (RS). 1 hhdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hhdc in each st to end of row. Turn. 23 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 hhdc in each st to end of row. Join A. **Do not** break B.

3rd row: With A, ch 1. 1 hdss in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. With A, 1 hdss in each st to last st of row. Work 1 hhdc in last st, Join B. Turn. **Do not** cut A.

5th row: As 3rd row.

6th row: Ch 1. 1 hhdc in each st to end of row. Join A.

Rep 3rd to 6th rows 5 times more. Fasten off.

Border

Place squares together so they are aligned with WS facing. With B, pull up a loop in top left hand corner and ch 3. Work one round of dc around the hot pad, working through both squares. Work 1 dc per row on the sides and one dc per stitch along top and bottom of hot pad, and work 3 dc in each corner.

When you reach the starting corner, work 3 dc around the starting ch-3, then continue working in the same direction around the hot pad, this time alternating dcfp and dcbp. Join with sl st to first dcfp. Fasten off.
