What you will need:

RED HEART® Gumdrop®: 1 ball
930 Orange A
and
RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball 3720
Lavender B

Susan Bates® knitting needles:
5mm [US 8]

Cable needle, yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 23
rows = 4" [10 cm]. **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE.** Use any size needles to
obtain the gauge given.

oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m) balls

 RED HEART® Soft®,

solid color 5 oz (141 g),

Doll-Sized Cowl & Beanie

*Girls will enjoy having these trendy cold
weather accessories for their doll. Beanie is
knit with cozy ribbing and cowl is sized to
easily fit over 18" doll's head.*

Fits 18" [45.72 cm] tall doll

Special Abbreviation

C8B (Right leaning cable): Slip next 4 sts to
cable needle and hold at the back of the work.
Knit the next 4 sts from left-hand needle. Knit
the next 4 sts from the cable needle.

COWL

With **A**, cast on 24 sts.
Row 1: K4, p4, k8, p4, k4.
Row 2: P4, k4, p8, k4, p4.
Row 3: K4, p4, k8, p4, k4.
Row 4: P4, k4, p8, k4, p4.
Row 5: K4, p4, C8B, p4, k4.
Row 6: P4, k4, p8, k4, p4.
Row 7: K4, p4, k8, p4, k4.
Row 8: P4, k4, p8, k4, p4.

Repeat Rows 1-8 eight times.
Bind off in pattern, leaving a 12" (30.48 cm)
long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

Thread tail onto yarn needle. Sew bind-off
edge to cast-on edge. Weave in all loose ends.

HAT

With **B**, cast on 48 sts, leaving a 12" (30.48
cm) tail for seaming the sides.
Rows 1-6: *K2, p2; repeat from * across.
Rows 7-21: Work in St st.
Row 22: K2tog across--24 sts.
Row 23: Purl.
Row 24: K2tog across--12 sts.
Row 25: Purl.

FINISHING

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) tail for
seaming. Thread tail onto yarn needle and
run yarn through all remaining sts on needle.
Draw up yarn to close, pulling tightly. Fasten
securely. Sew sides together with remaining
long tail from cast on. Weave in all loose ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A = Color A; **B** = Color B; **K** = knit; **K2tog** =
knit next 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **P**
= Purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette
stitch; * = repeat whatever follows the * as
indicated.
