Yarn needle

GAUGE: 19 sts and 27 rows =
4" (10 cm) in Stockinette st.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use
any size needles to obtain the
gauge.

SHOP KIT

Play Misty Stripe Pullover

This wonderful yarn automatically gives you stripes with misty transitions from color to color. Choose from beautiful color combinations and knit a new very wearable sweater for your collection.

Directions are for size **Small**. Changes for sizes **Medium, Large, Extra Large, 2X Large and 3X Large** are in parentheses.

Sweater measures 43 (46, 51½, 54½, 60, 63)" (109 (117, 131, 138.5, 152.5, 160) cm) around bust and 22 (23, 24, 25, 26, 27)" (56 (58.5, 61, 63.5, 66, 68.5) cm).

SPECIAL STITCH

Ssk (slip, slip, knit) = Slip next 2 sts knitwise to right needle, insert point of left needle through front of sts, knit these sts together through back loop.

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on 118 (126, 138, 146, 158, 166) sts.

Row 1 (wrong side): P2, * k2, p2; repeat from * to end.

Row 2: K2, * p2, k2; repeat from * to end.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 4" (10 cm), ending with after a wrong side row.

Change to larger needles.

Next row (dec row, right side): * K6 (7, 7, 8, 9, 9), k2tog; repeat from * 13 more times, knit to end - 104 (112, 124, 132, 144, 152) sts.

Work evenly in Stockinette st until piece measures 22 (23, 24, 25, 26, 27)" (56 (58.5, 61, 63.5, 66, 68.5), ending after a wrong side row.

Bind off all sts.

FRONT

Work same as Back until piece measures 20 (21, 22, 23, 24, 25)" (51 (53.5, 56, 58.5, 61, 63.5) cm), ending after a wrong side row.

Separate for Neck

Next row (right side): K36 (40, 45, 49, 54, 58), join another ball of yarn and bind off center 32 (32, 34, 34, 36, 36) sts, k to end.



Right Shoulder

Row 1 (wrong side): Purl.

Row 2: K1, ssk, knit to end - 35 (39, 44, 48, 53, 57) sts.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times - 32 (36, 41, 45, 50, 54) sts.

Work 3 more rows evenly in Stockinette st, then bind off all sts.

Left Shoulder

Row 1 (wrong side): Purl.

Row 2: Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 35 (39, 44, 48, 53, 57) sts.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times – 32 (36, 41, 45, 50, 54) sts.

Work 3 more rows evenly in Stockinette st, then bind off all sts.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Place a marker at each side edge of Front and Back, 6½ (6¾, 7¼, 7¾, 8, 8½)" (16.5 (17, 18.5, 19.5, 20.5, 21.5) cm) below shoulder seam.

With right facing, using larger needles, pick up and knit 62 (66, 70, 74, 78, 82) sts evenly along edge of armhole from marker to marker.

Work 9 (9, 7, 5, 5, 5) rows evenly in Stockinette st beginning and ending with a wrong side (purl) row.

Next row (decrease row, right side): K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 60 (64, 68, 72, 76, 80) sts.

Continuing in Stockinette st, repeat this decrease every 8 (6, 6, 6, 6, 6) rows 9 (11, 8, 7, 3, 0) more times, then every 4 rows 0 (0, 5, 6, 12, 17) more times – 42 (42, 42, 46, 46, 46) sts.

Work 9 (9, 9, 7, 5, 3) rows evenly.

Change to smaller needles.

Next 2 rows:

Row 1 (right side): K2, * p2, k2; repeat from * to end.

Row 2: P2, * k2, p2; repeat from * to end. Repeat last 2 rows 11 more times. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Sew front to back at shoulders.

Collar

With right side facing, and small circular needle, pick up and knit 42 (42, 44, 44, 46, 46) sts across Back neck edge, 10 sts down Left Front neck edge, 34 (34, 36, 36, 38, 38) sts across Front neck edge, and 10 sts up Right Front neck edge – 96 (96, 100, 100, 104, 104) sts. Join round and mark first st.

Round 1: * K2, p2; repeat from * around. Repeat this round until collar measures 4" (10 cm). Loosely bind off all sts.

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Weave in all loose ends.

Block to finished measurements, stretching lower ribbing slightly during blocking.

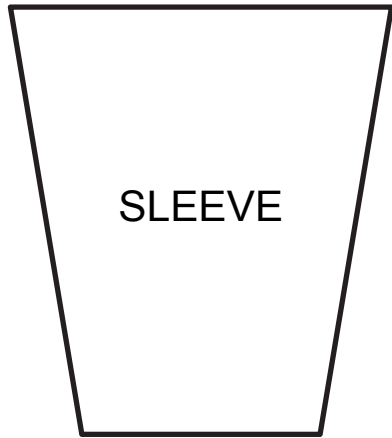
ABBREVIATIONS

dec = decrease; **k** = knit; **k2tog** = knit next 2 sts together; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.

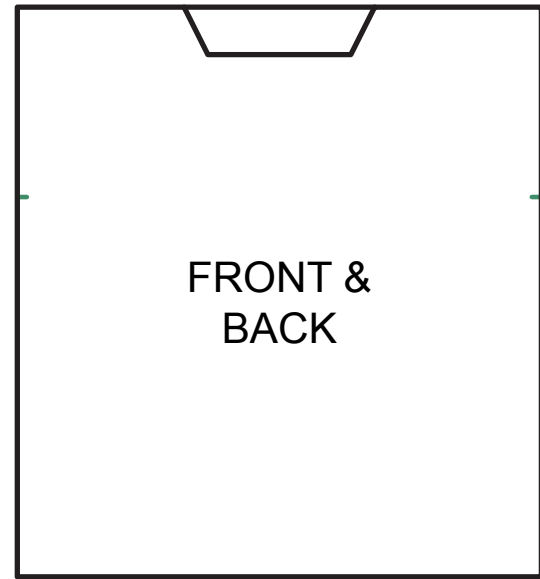
