## What you will need:

### RED HEART® With Love®:

1 skein each 1207 Cornsilk **A**,  
1308 Tan **B**, 1542 Aubergine **C**,  
1601 Lettuce **D**, 1621 Evergreen  
**E**, 1914 Berry Red **F**, and 1939  
Papaya **G**

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
4mm [US G-6]

Susan Bates® Split lock stitch  
markers

18" (45.5 cm) burlap-wrapped  
straw wreath, approximately  
100 greening pins, floral wire  
(found in floral department  
of most craft stores), small  
amounts of plush stuffing,  
yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 16 sc = 4" (10 cm).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use  
any size hook to obtain the  
gauge.

# Fabulous Fall Wreath

Use your crochet skill to create a wreath of amazing autumn colors! These small pieces are great for having a take along project. And the finished wreath is perfect for giving your front door a color boost.

**Wreath measures 18" (45.5 cm) in diameter.**

## NOTE

All leaves, grapes and acorns are worked in the round with right side always facing.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**Picot** = Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.  
**Sc2tog (single crochet 2 together)** =  
[Pull up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over  
and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

**Magic ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail. Insert hook under both strands, and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and begin working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.



## SINGLE-POINT LEAF (make 25 with each B and D)

Ch 12.

**Round 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in each of next 3 ch, tr in each of next 2 ch, dc in each of next 3 ch, 4 sc in last ch, rotate piece to work across unused loops at opposite side of foundation ch, dc in each of next 3 ch, tr in each of next 2 ch, dc in each of next 3 ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, slip st in last ch.

**Round 2:** Sc in each of first 12 sts, ch 2, slip st in 2nd ch from hook (leaf point made), sc in each of next 12 sts, slip st in base of leaf, ch 4, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 2 ch, slip st in base of leaf (stem made).  
Fasten off and weave in ends.



## FIVE-POINT LEAF (make 12 with F and 6 with G)

Create a Magic Ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 11 dc in ring, join with slip st in 3rd of beginning ch-3 - 12 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), picot, dc in first dc, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 3 ch (stem made), dc in same dc as last dc, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, (dc, picot, dc) in next dc, (sc, hdc) in next dc, (dc, picot, sc) in next dc, (hdc, dc, tr, picot, tr, dc, hdc) in next dc, (sc, picot, dc) in next dc, (hdc, sc) in last st, join with a slip st in 3rd of beginning ch-6.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### OAK LEAF (make 6 with A)

With **A**, ch 13.

**Round 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next ch, hdc in each of next 3 ch, dc in each of next 3 ch, tr in each of next 4 ch, 6 tr in last ch, rotate piece to work across unused loops at opposite side of foundation ch, tr in each of next 4 ch, dc in each of next 3 ch, hdc in each of next 3 ch, sc in each of next 2 ch, slip st in last ch.

**Round 2:** Hdc in 1st st, skip next st, (3 dc, ch 3, slip st) in next st, slip st in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, (3 tr, ch 4, slip st) in next st, slip st in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, (2 tr, ch 4, slip st) in next st, slip st in next st, (hdc, dc, tr) in next st, (tr, dc, hdc) in next st, slip st in next st, (slip st, ch 4, 2 tr) in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in next st, (slip st, ch 4, 3 tr) in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in next st, (slip st, ch 3, 3 dc) in next st, skip next st, hdc in next st, sl in base of leaf, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in each of next 3 ch, slip st in base of leaf (stem made).

Fasten off and weave in ends.



### GRAPE LEAF (make 6 with E)

Create a magic ring.

**Round 1:** 5 sc in ring. Mark first st, and move marker up as each round is completed.

**Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc around - 10 sc.

**Round 3:** 2 sc in each sc around, join with slip st in first sc - 20 sc.

**Round 4:** \* Ch 2, hdc in next st, (dc, ch 1, tr, ch 1, dc) in next st, hdc in next st, ch 2, sc in next st; repeat from \* 4 more times, slip st base of leaf, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 3 ch, slip st in base of leaf (stem made).

Fasten off and weave in ends.



### LARGE GRAPE (make 3 with C)

Create a magic ring.

**Round 1:** 5 sc in ring. Mark first st, and move marker up as each round is completed.

**Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc around - 10 sc.

**Round 3:** \* 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* around - 15 sc.

**Rounds 4-6:** Sc in each sc around.

**Round 7:** \* Sc2tog over next 2 sc, sc in next st; repeat from \* around - 10 sc.

Pause here and stuff grape.

**Round 8:** \* Sc2tog over next 2 sc, repeat from \* around - 5 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) tail.

Weave tail through remaining 5 sts and pull tight to close hole. Leave remaining tail to attach to smaller grapes.



### SMALL GRAPE (make 9 with C)

Create a magic ring.

**Round 1:** 5 sc in ring. Mark first st, and move marker up as each round is completed.

**Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc around - 10 sc.

**Rounds 3 and 4:** Sc in each sc around. Pause here and stuff grape.

**Round 5:** \* Sc2tog over next 2 sc; repeat from \* around - 5 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail.

Weave tail through remaining 5 sts and pull tight to close hole.

Weave in ends to inside of Grape.



### ACORN BOTTOM (make 6 with D and 3 with E)

Create a magic ring.

Work Rounds 1-6 same as Large Grape.

**Round 7:** \* Sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from \* around, join with slip st in first sc - 12 sc.

Fasten off.

### ACORN CAP (make 9 with B)

Create a magic ring, leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) tail to create stem after cap is made.

**Round 1:** 5 sc in ring. Mark first st, and move marker up as each round is completed.

**Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc around - 10 sc.

**Round 3:** \* 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* around - 15 sc.

**Round 4:** \* 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from \* around - 20 sc.

**Round 5:** \* Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc; repeat from \* around, join with slip st in first sc - 15 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) tail to sew to Acorn Bottom.

Weave beginning tail to inside through center top of Cap.

From the outside, insert hook in center top and pull a loop up to create first st of stem, ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 2 ch, slip st in top of Cap (stem made).

Fasten off.

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Lightly stuff acorn and sew Cap to Bottom.

Weave in ends to inside of Acorn.

## FINISHING

Thread greening pins through back of each leaf so that it does not show on front of leaf.

Referring to photo for placement, attach 3 pairs of Grape Leaves to Wreath, evenly spaced.

Attach 3 pairs of Oak Leaves, 1 centered between each pair of Grape Leaves.

Use yarn tail on each Large Grape to attach 3 Small Grapes and create a bunch. Attach a bunch with greening pin to each pair of Grape Leaves.

Thread stems of 3 Acorns onto greening pin to create a bunch. Attach a bunch to each pair of Oak Leaves.

Attach Single-Point Leaves, in alternating colors, around inner and outer edges of Wreath.

Attach 3 Five-Point Leaves in a row, in colors **F**, then **G**, then **F**, to front of Wreath in each space between grape and acorn bunches.

Use floral wire to create hanger for wreath.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C etc;  
**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet;  
**st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\* or \*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
