



## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Super Value™** (7 oz/197 g; 426 yds/389 m)

**Contrast A** Baby Pink (07438) **1 ball**

**Contrast B** Soft Grey (53046) **1 ball**

**Contrast C** Bright Yellow (00608) **1 ball**

**Contrast D** Oatmeal (53010) **1 ball**

**Contrast E** Black (07421) **1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 1 button.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 11" [28 cm] long x 3" [7.5 cm] wide.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** To join colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color, yoh with new color and proceed.

### Back

\*\*With A, ch 11.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 10 sc.

**2nd to 6th rows:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Break A, join B at end of last row.

**7th row:** With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**8th row:** Ch 1. Scfl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**9th row:** Ch 1. *Working in both loops*, 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**10th row:** Ch 1. Scfl in each sc to end of row. Break B, join C.

**11th to 28th rows:** With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.\*\* Break C, join D.

**29th row:** With D, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**30th row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 8 sts.

## GAUGE:

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

**31st row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

**32nd row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 6 sts.

**33rd row:** As 31st row.

**34th row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Break D, join E. Turn. 4 sts.

**35th row:** With E, as 31st row.

**36th row:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.

**37th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each of 2 sts. Turn.

**Make button loop:** Ch 6. Skip 1st sc. Join with sl st to last sc. Fasten off.

### Front

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back. Fasten off at end of 28th row.

### Assembly

With WS of Front and Back tog, align bottom edges. *Working through both thicknesses*, join edges with sl st, changing color as needed to match Pencil colors. Sew button to front to correspond with button loop.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Ch** = Chain

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2tog** = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

**Scfl** = Single crochet in front loop only

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook
