What you will need:

Red Heart® Fashion Soft™: 1 ball each 4705 Hot Pink **A** and 9440 Grey Heather **B**

1 Set (5) Susan Bates® Double-Pointed Knitting Needles: 3.75mm [US 5]

Yarn Needle, stitch marker, stitch holder

GAUGE: 24 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette Stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Fashion Soft™, Art. E845 available in solid colors of 5 oz (141 g), 381 yd (348 m) balls

Sleek Striped Wristers

Choose two shades of this lighter weight yarn and knit up a pair of wristers for yourself or a friendly gift. They are knit in the round on double pointed needles for a comfy fit.

Finished measurements: 5.25" [13 cm] long and 6.5" [16 cm] in circumference

Wristers fit most women.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

KFB = Knit Front and Back. Knit both the front and the back of the stitch, (increase 1 st).

NOTES

Striped Wristers are knit in the round on double-pointed needles. Carry yarn not in use up the side of work. Wristers are worked from bottom to top-cuff/wrist to palm/fingers.

STRIPED WRISTERS (make 2) Cuff

With **A**, cast on 40 sts divided evenly on 4 double-pointed needles (10 sts on each needle); join to work in the round, being careful stitches are not twisted. Place stitch marker at beginning of round, moving marker with each round.

Rounds 1-4: Knit.

Begin Stripe Pattern

Rounds 5-6: With **B** knit. Do not cut **A**, carry up side of work.

Rounds 7-8: With **A** knit. Do not cut **B**, carry up side of work.

Rounds 9-20: Repeat Rounds 5-8. Increase Round

Next Round: With **B**, k1, KFB, knit to last 2 sts, KFB, k1 — 42 sts.

Round 2: Knit.

Thumb Gusset

Round 1: With **A**, k1, KFB, knit to last 2 stitches, KFB, k1 — 44 sts.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: With **B**, k1, KFB, knit to last 2 stitches, KFB, k1 — 46 sts.

Round 4: Knit.

Repeats Rounds 1-4 until 50 sts.

Next Round: With **A**, knit.

Next Round: Place 5 sts from beginning of Round and 5 sts from end of Round on stitch holder (10 sts). These are the Thumb sts. Cut **A**.

Next Rounds: Continue in stripe pattern, knit 2 Rounds **B**, 2 Rounds **A**, over remaining 40 sts, carrying yarn not in use up the side of work until you have a total of 10 **B** stripes.

Top of Wrister (rolled edge)

Rounds 1-4: With **A**, knit. Bind off all sts on last Round.

Thumb

Round 1: Working in the round with **B**, place the 10 sts from the stitch holder on 2 needles (5 sts on each needle), pick up and knit 5 sts from Thumb opening and place on 3rd needle) — 15 sts.

Round 2: Knit.

Rounds 3-4: With **A**, knit.

Rounds 5-6: With **B**, knit.

Rounds 7-8: With **A**, knit.

Round 9: With **B**, knit and bind off all sts.

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SHOP KIT

Finishing

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = colors A, B; **cm** = centimeters; **K** = knit; **KFB** = Knit Front and Back; **P** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
