What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein each 319 Cherry Red A
and 316 Soft White B

**Susan Bates® Double-Pointed
Needles:** 1 Set 5 mm [US 8]
Susan Bates® Easy Wrap Pom
Pon Maker, stitch marker,
yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm];
22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in
Stockinette Stitch. **CHECK
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size
needle to obtain the gauge.**

Holiday Stripes Dog Scarf

Your best friend will look fashionably warm
in this knit scarf designed just for pets.
Pattern is written for medium-size dog, with
notes in the pattern to adjust for other sizes.

SHOP KIT

Pet Scarf measures: 3½" [8 cm] wide
x 27" [30 cm] long. Scarf fits most
medium-sized dogs. Size is adaptable,
instructions are given throughout the
pattern, read each section carefully.

SPECIAL STITCHES

K2TOG = Knit 2 stitches together
(decrease).

SSK = Slip, slip, knit. (decrease).

NOTES: The first section of the Scarf
is worked back and forth in rows. Then
stitches are cast on for second section
and scarf is completed by working in
the round.

SCARF

Section 1

With **A**, cast on 14 sts leaving an 18"
[46 cm] tail.

(You can adjust the width here by
adding or subtracting stitches in
multiples of 2.)

Row 1 (Right Side): Join **B** and knit
across row.

Row 2 (Right Side): Slide stitches back
to beginning of needle and with **A**, knit
across row. Turn.

Row 3 (Wrong Side): With **B**, purl
across row.

Row 4 (Wrong Side): Slide stitches back
to beginning of needle and with **A**, purl
across row. Turn.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until piece measures 9"
[23 cm] from cast on edge, end with a
Row 2.

Section 2

Continuing with **A**, cast on 7 sts. Place
stitch marker and then with **B**, cast on 7
sts—28 sts.

(If you have adjusted the width, make
sure to cast on the same number of
stitches that you have, the first half
with **A** and the second half with **B**, to
complete the round.)

Divide stitches evenly on 3 double-
pointed needles and join.

Continuing with **B**, knit 21 sts, (you will
be at stitch marker).

Round 1: With **A**, knit around.

Round 2: With **B**, knit around.

Repeat Rounds 1-2 until piece measures
31" [79 cm] from cast on edge. (You
can adjust the length here to fit your
pet. Remember to add enough length to
slide through loop.)

Rearrange stitches so that there are
7 sts on the first needle, 14 sts on the
second needle and 7 sts on the third
needle. (If you have adjusted the width,
divide your stitches with ¼ onto first
needle, ½ onto second needle and last ¼
onto third needle.)

Next Round:

Needle 1: Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Needle 2: K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts,
k2tog, k1.

Needle 3: K1, ssk, knit to end of round.
Repeat last Round, 4 times—8 sts
remain.

Bind off all stitches leaving a tail 10"
[25 cm] long for seaming end of scarf.

FINISHING

Fold cast on edge of first section of
scarf to cast on stitches of second
section with Wrong Sides together. With
yarn tail and Yarn Needle, whip stitch
into place leaving side edges of first
section free to form loop.

Seam pointed end of scarf. With **A** and
B held together, make a 3¼" [8 cm]
pompom and attach to pointed end
of scarf.

Weave in ends. Lightly block scarf.

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ABBREVIATIONS

A = Color A; **B** = Color B; **cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **K2TOG** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **SSK** = slip, slip, knit; **St st** = Stockinette stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
